2019 D2CCA All-East Region Women's Soccer Teams Announced
Saint Rose's Predanic Captures East Region Player of the Year Accolade

FLUSHING, N.Y. (Nov. 20, 2019) – Senior forward Nina Predanic of The College of Saint Rose has been named Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCA) Women's Soccer East Region Player of the Year as part of the full announcement of the D2CCA All-East Region women's soccer teams on Wednesday (Nov. 20). The teams were voted on by the Sports Information Directors of the East Region.

Predanic, a 2018 All-East Region First Team honoree who also received Second-Team accolades in 2016, was a pivotal reason for the Golden Knights' success in the 2019 campaign. The senior from Slovenia finished the regular season with 15 goals, adding three more in the Northeast-10 Tournament Championship to compile 18 goals and 49 total points on the season thus far. Predanic was a four-time All-Northeast-10 Conference honoree and the 2019 NE-10 Player of the Year for Saint Rose, the No. 1 team in the East Region for the upcoming NCAA Tournament.

The Golden Knights also had the most players named to the Division II CCA All-Region honor lists with five players in total. However, the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference (CACC) led all schools with ten selections among their respective programs. The East Coast Conference (ECC) had eight players named to the All-Region teams; Georgian Court led the CACC with four selections while Mercy and Bridgeport had three picks each.

The First Team members now advance to the national ballot as potential All-America honorees. Predanic will be moved forward to the Ron Lenz National Player of the Year voting along with the seven other Regional Players of the Year across the Division II landscape.

The Division II Conference Commissioners Association encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of higher education. The CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact Division II intercollegiate athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.
