

#### JUMP BALL

Daemen's three-game exhibition slate comes to an end Tuesday night as the Wildcats make their Lumsden Gymnasium debut by hosting Mohawk out of the Ontario Colleges Athletic Association (OCAA). Although it won't count as an official meeting, the Wildcats and Mountaineers will be playing for the first time since an 83-52 Daemen win on Jan. 12, 2000. It also marks Daemen's first game against a Canadian opponent since Oct. 30, 2015 when the Wildcats downed Brock 102-95. Mohawk has played five contests so far this season, posting a 1-4 record. The Wildcats are coming off a pair of high-profile exhibition games last week against Division I foes Buffalo and Syracuse. Daemen suffered a 111-73 loss at UB on Oct. 24, surrendering a game-closing 21-6 spurt over the final 6:03 to inflate the final margin. Two days later the Wildcats made their first-ever appearance at Syracuse, and played the Orange to an even second half score (43-43) in a 90-71 loss.





#### **ECC 30TH ANNIVERSARY**

The East Coast Conference is celebrating 30 years as an NCAA Division II conference throughout the 2019-20 season.

"It is my honor to be Commissioner as the East Coast Conference, and before that the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference, celebrates its 30th year as an NCAA Division II athletic association," said ECC Commissioner, Dr. Robert Dranoff. "This is an athletic conference that can truly boast about success in the classroom, on the playing field, and in the community. We are proud of all the studentathletes, coaches, and administrators who have made their mark in so many ways, contributing to their institutions and to the ECC and NCAA.'

The ECC was formed during the 1989-90 season under its former name, the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference. The league started with 10members competing in nine sports (men's basketball, baseball, softball, men's soccer, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's cross country, and men's golf).

The ECC currently has 10 member institutions in New York, Connecticut, and Washington, D.C. Four charter members, Mercy College, Molloy College, New York Tech, and Queens College, have competed in the conference throughout its 30 years. In all, 20 institutions have called the ECC home since its inception.

Rebranded as the East Coast Conference before the 2006-2007 season, the league has grown to currently offer 19 championship sports, 10 of which have access to automatic bids into the NCAA Championship. The ECC has been home to 23 Division II National Championship teams and one individual National Championship, as well.



## MIKE MACDONALD

#### **HEAD COACH • SIXTH SEASON • ST. BONAVENTURE. '88**

The 2019-20 season will mark Mike MacDonald's sixth year as the Head Men's Basketball Coach at Daemen College. All he's done over the last half-decade is lead the Wildcats to the second-most wins among all Division II programs in New York State. Since being <a href="introduced as the sixth head">introduced as the sixth head</a> <a href="coach">coach</a> in the modern history of the program on September 16, 2014, <a href="MacDonald">MacDonald</a> has guided the Wildcats to a 105-43 overall record, wins in nearly 75 percent of their conference games (70-24 record) and five top-three finishes in the East Coast Conference standings.

MacDonald holds more than 30 years of collegiate coaching experience, including the last 22 as a head coach. In that time, he's compiled a record of 361-269 (.573 winning percentage) as a head coach, while also graduating 83 of the 86 seniors he has ever coached.

The 2018-19 season was the team's finest since transitioning to the NCAA Division II level. MacDonald led the Wildcats to a 24-6 record and the program's second ECC regular-season title. The Wildcats spent a combined 16 weeks ranked in the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA) top-25 national polls, and earned their first-ever NCAA tournament berth.

MacDonald recorded milestones and received several accolades along the way in 2018-19. His 350th career win came in dramatic fashion on January 18 as junior guard Breon Harris scored five points in the final 21 seconds to lift the Wildcats past Mercy 75-74. His 100th win at Daemen came February 10, placing MacDonald among an elite fraternity of coaches who have achieved at least 100 wins while coaching in each of the NCAA's three divisions. That achievement propelled him to HoopDirt.com Division II Coach of the Week honors, and he went on to be named the ECC Coach fo the Year, the NABC District Coach of the Year and the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY) Division II Coach of the Year.

The Wildcat faithful become familiar with MacDonald's fiery style during the 2014-15 season as the veteran mentor guided Daemen to its fourth straight 20-win season, including a 13-7 mark in the East Coast Conference, good for a third-place finish in the final league standings. The fireworks got started before the season even officially began as MacDonald led the Wildcats to an 83-81 win in overtime over Canisius College in an exhibition game on November 11, 2014 at the Koessler Athletic Center. It was Daemen's first-ever victory against an NCAA Division I opponent.

MacDonald's official Daemen debut came just days later as his Wildcats walloped Concordia College (N.Y.), 88-50, in the opening round of the ECC-CACC Challenge before a raucous home crowd at Lumsden Gymnasium. MacDonald would go on to lead the team to wins in his first nine home games, extending the program's NCAA Division II-best home-court winning streak to 44 consecutive before a buzzer-beating three-pointer in overtime by eventual ECC Player of the Year Darian Hooker lifted N.Y. Institute of Technology past Daemen (85-84) to snap the streak on January 24, 2015.

Depsite losing two starters to season-ending injuries, including first-team All-ECC selection Torrence Dyck, MacDonald helped the Wildcats advance to the postseason. With Daemen's teams still ineligible for ECC and/or NCAA Division II postseason, Daemen elected to partake in the United States Collegiate Athletic Association (USCAA) Division I National Championships in Uniontown, Pa., entering the tournament as the No. 1 overall seed. While there, MacDonald guided Daemen to wins over No. 8 Indiana-South Bend (69-63), No. 4 Concordia College (Ala.) (68-63) and No. 3 Rochester College (Mich.) (77-53) to capture the program's first USCAA national title, riding USCAA Division I Player of the Year and National Championships MVP Gerald Beverly to the tourney crown.

At the conclusion of the 2014-15 season, MacDonald was named the BCANY Division II Coach of the Year.

The 2015-16 season marked Daemen's first as a full-fledged NCAA Division II member, and it presented its share of challenges. Starting guards Supreme Hannah and Nick Petrucelli were lost to season-ending injuries, but that didn't stop MacDonald from leading the team to new and unprecedented heights. After opening the season with just three wins in their first eight outings, the Wildcats hit their stride after the calendar turned to January, scoring 15 wins in the final 19 games of the regular season.

A 94-81 win over Mercy on January 9 jump-started what turned out to be a nine-game winning streak. Included in the string was a miraculous 98-96 win over Roberts Wesleyan on January 12. Dyck's driving layup with four seconds remaining gave Daemen the lead after erasing a 22-point deficit over the final six minutes of the contest.

Daemen's 14-6 league record was good for a second-place finish in the final regular season standings, earning them the No. 2 seed and a bye into the semifinal round of the ECC Tournament which would mark the program's first-ever postseason berth at the NCAA Division II level. Taking on sixth-seeded Mercy in the semis, Daemen came through with a 103-102 win in overtime, advancing to the tournament finals. There, the Wildcats' season came to an end against top-seeded St. Thomas Aquinas.



The 2016-17 season saw MacDonald lead the Wildcats to 5-0 start out of the gates, including the veteran coach's 300th career win which came at Edinboro University (90-79) on November 23.

MacDonald's team would rebound from a four-game slide to rattle off 11 wins in 13 outings between mid-December and early-February. Included in the stretch was a 67-64 win over No. 23 St. Thomas Aquinas on January 4 - the Wildcats' first-ever victory against a ranked opponent at the NCAA Division II level. The Wildcats would go on to close the regular season at 18-8 overall and 12-6 in ECC play; the team's 12 league wins placed them fourth in the final ECC regular season standings.

Making their second straight ECC Tournament appearance, MacDonald led the Wildcats to a 73-71 win over fifth-seeded District of Columbia in the opening round. The win pushed the Wildcats' home record to 14-2 on the season, tying the team record for home wins in a season. The 2016-17 campaign came to an end in the semifinal round of the tournament where top-seeded St. Thomas Aguinas emerged victorious.

Before arriving at Daemen, MacDonald spent eight years leading the men's basketball team at Medaille College (2006-14) where he transformed the program into a regional contender at the NCAA Division III level. Inheriting a program that went

4-46 in the two years prior to his arrival, MacDonald's version of the Mavericks averaged 18 wins per season, while advancing to the postseason six times.

Medaille's emergence as a Division III power in the Northeast was cemented in MacDonald's final five seasons there, as he led the Mavericks to more wins (101) than any other Division III team in New York State, while ranking 17th nationally in wins during the same time frame.

MacDonald was named the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions (2006-07, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2011-12). He left Medaille as the school's all-time leader in wins (148) and winning percentage (.670).

Prior to his stint at Medaille, MacDonald served as the head coach at Canisius College from 1997-2006, guiding the Golden Griffins to 108 wins which ranks him third in program history for coaching victories. While there, he was one of only five coaches in that program's storied history to orchestrate a 20-win season, and was named the 2000-01 BCANY Division I Co-Coach of the Year.

Before being elevated to the head coaching post at Canisius, MacDonald had been the Golden Griffins' top assistant coach under John Beilein, now the head coach of the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers. In that role, MacDonald helped Canisius reach the 1996 NCAA Tournament in addition to two National Invitational Tournament appearances.

In addition to his coaching accomplishments, MacDonald brings a strong connection to the local community. His teams have been active with a number of community organizations in the greater Buffalo community and beyond, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Buffalo, Blessed Sacrament Athletic Club and Coaches vs. Cancer. MacDonald and several of his players have also worked with the Drug Enforcement Administration and Mayor Byron Brown's office on the "Game Changers" program which provides academic and athletic opportunities for inner-city youths during the summer months.

A 1988 graduate of Saint Bonaventure University, MacDonald resides in Amherst with his wife Maura (nee Heary). The couple has raised four children - Matthew, Patrick, Nicholas and Mark. Matthew served as team captain during his collegiate career at the University of Pennsylvania and is now a player development assistant with the Brooklyn Nets. Patrick was a Division III All-American while playing at the State University of New York Maritime College, and is now enlisted in the United States Navy. Nicholas is a freshman on the basketball team at Niagara University where he plays for Beilein's son, Patrick

#### WHAT A RIDE

The 2018-19 season was one for the record books at Daemen as the Wildcats captured their second East Coast Conference regular season title, sat atop the regional rankings for much of the campaign, ascended into the top-25 national polls for the first time as an NCAA Division II member and garnered the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament bid. The Wildcats rattled off wins in 11 of their first 12 games, including a 78-72 defeat of previously unbeaten St. Anselm who came into the Jan. 2 contest ranked No. 4 in both Division II national polls. Daemen embarked on a 10-game winning streak beginning in mid-January, a stretch that vaulted them to the top of the regional poll and as high as No. 10 (D2SIDA) and No. 13 (NABC) in the top-25 national polls. It marked the Wildcats' longest winning streak since the 2013-14 season when they won 14 consecutive games. The Wildcats wrapped up the ECC regular season title with a 93-71 defeat of Bridgeport on March 3. They entered the ECC Championship tournament as the No. 1 seed, but were upset by fourth-seeded Bridgeport in game played at UB's Hubbell Gymnasium. Despite the conference tournament loss, Daemen was awarded an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament, earning the No. 5 seed to the East Region Championship. They made their NCAA tourney debut March 16, but saw their season come to an end with a 72-67 loss to fourth-seeded New Haven. The team's 24 wins this season were the most since their transition to NCAA Division II.

#### **BECOMING THE NORM**

Daemen's 108-63 win over LIU Post last Feb. 15 was their 20th of the 2018-19 season. It marked Daemen's sixth 20-win campaign in the last eight seasons. Daemen has not won less than 19 games in a season since the 2010-11 campaign. Finishing the year at 24-6, it marked the program's most in a season since going 27-6 during the 2012-13 campaign, a year before the Wildcats began play as members of the East Coast Conference.

#### **DEFENDING THE DEN**

Daemen posted a 15-1 record at the friendly confines of Lumsden Gymnasium last season, reaching double-figure home wins for the seventh time in the last eight seasons, and establishing a new benchmark for home-court wins in a single season. Daemen's 14th home win of the season came on March 1 with an 89-69 defeat of Mercy, matching the prior

team record which was established during both the 1999-2000 and 2016-17 seasons. The Wildcats broke that mark with a 93-71 win over Bridgeport in the regular-season finale on March 3. The Wildcats have won 23 of their last 25 home games dating back to the 2017-18 season, as well as their last eight in a row. Since joining the ECC (2013-14 season), Daemen is 48-9 in home conference games (.842 winning percentage). Since the start of the 2011-12 season, Daemen is 97-14 at Lumsden Gymnasium (.874 winning percentage). Of those 14 losses, six have been decided by three points or fewer, including three by just a single point.

#### **NATIONAL SPOTLIGHT**

For the first time as a member of NCAA Division II, Daemen opens the season as a nationally-ranked team. The Wildcats are No. 22 in the NABC preseason top-25 poll which was released in late October. Daemen's preseason ranking comes after spending the final seven weeks of the 2018-19 season included in the NABC poll. The Wildcats debuted in the poll at No. 23 last January 29, and rose as high as No. 13 (Feb. 19) before finishing the season at No. 22. Daemen will play three games against teams included in the preseason top-25, and four more against teams that are presently receiving votes. The Wildcats open the regular season this Friday, Nov. 1 against No. 1 Northwest Missouri State University as part of the Small College Basketball National Hall of Fame Classic. The Bearcats are coming off a perfect 38-0 season, and have won two of the last three national championships. Additional games against top-25 teams come Nov. 16 when the Wildcats host No. 4 West Liberty University, and Jan. 1 at No. 21 Saint Anselm College. The Daemen-Saint Anselm matchup will the second in as many seasons. The Wildcats defeated the Hawks, then ranked No. 4 in the NABC poll, 78-72 at Lumsden Gymnasium last January.

#### **EVERYTHING'S WAITING FOR YOU DOWNTOWN**

Daemen will make their first-ever appearance at KeyBank Center, downtown Buffalo's largest sports venue, on Saturday, Nov. 23 when the Wildcats host Wilmington (Del.). The 19,000-seat arena has been the site of the NCAA Division I men's basketball tournament six times since its opening in 1996. The Daemen-Wilmington game comes as part of a doubleheader with Division I teams from Canisius and St. Bonaventure hitting the KeyBank hardwood that day as well.

#### MAN IN THE MIDDLE

Redshirt-junior center <u>Andrew Sischo</u> headlines Daemen's returning players after earning East Coast Conference and Division II Conference Commissioner's Association East Region Player of the Year honors in 2018-19. A two-time first-team All-ECC selection, Sischo has been downright dominant over the last two seasons for the Wildcats. He has set new team benchmarks for points scored by a freshman (462) and sophomore (585), and is already one of only 10 players in program history with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds. Sischo recorded 17 double-doubles last season, ranking first among all ECC players and sixth nationally, while also becoming just the sixth player in team history to average a double-double (20.9 ppg, 10.1 rpg) for an entire season.

#### **THREE-DICULOUS SHOOTING**

Over his first three collegiate seasons, forward <u>Jeff Redband</u> has established himself as one of the preeminent three-point shooters in the ECC, as well as among Daemen's all-time leaders. Redband is the first Daemen player with 60 or more three-pointers in three straight seasons since Brian Montanaro did so four straight times from 2002-06. A two-time All-ECC pick, including a second-team selection last season, Redband has appeared in all 88 games since the start of the 2016-17 season, making 85 starts and averaging 11.5 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. He ranks fourth in team history with 216 three-point field goals, and he's made at least one trifecta in 32 of the last 34 games.

#### **BREAKOUT BREON**

Senior guard <u>Breon Harris</u> has helped Daemen to wins in 41 of 49 games since he was inserted into the starting lineup midway through the 2017-18 season. He's been a third-team All-ECC selection in each of the last two seasons, and has also earned ECC Championships All-Tournament Team honors twice in his career. After making just two three-point field goals over the first 21 games of his career, Harris has racked up 82 trifectas in

his last 48 games, making at least one in 41 games. He swiped 70 steals as a sophomore, the third-highest single-season total in team history and making him the first player with at least 70 since Russell John totaled 73 in 1990-91. Harris added 53 steals to his career total last season, becoming just the fifth player to lead the Wildcats in steals at least twice, and the first player with 50+ steals in consecutive seasons since Mark Coppola in 2011-12 and 2012-13.

#### **SHINING STAR-KIS**

Redshirt-senior guard <u>Jay Sarkis</u> has been a fixture in the Daemen lineup since arriving on campus in 2015. A three-year starter, Sarkis has appeared in 82 of a possible 89 games (excluding a redshirt season in 2016-17), and made 76 starts. He's recorded at least one three-pointer in 68 games, totaling 147 triples in his career. Sarkis contributed 8.2 points and a team-best 3.1 assists per game in 2018-19. His finest season came a year earlier when he put up career-highs in points (372), assists (106) and rebounds (86), and finished the season ranking among the ECC's top-five statistical leaders in minutes (3rd), minutes per game (5th), three-point field goals (4th), three-point shooting percentage (5th) and assists (3rd).

#### **FRESH FACES**

The Wildcats welcome 10 new players to the fold this season to round out a large 20-player roster. While some of the newcomers are expected to redshirt, several are expected to make immediate impacts. Redshirt-senior guard <u>Joey Wallace</u> is the most experienced of the bunch. The son of former Syracuse star and NBA veteran John Wallace, <u>Joey Wallace</u> holds 85 games of Division II experience under his belt across parts of four seasons playing for Southern Connecticut State. The Rochester native contributed 8.7 points and 5.1 rebounds per game across his tenure there. Buffalo natives <u>Donte'</u> <u>Williams</u> and <u>Kyle Harris</u> are also proven college players. Williams, a 6'4" guard/forward, has one season of remaining eligibility following previous stops at

He averaged 10.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game for the Vulcans last season. Harris comes over after a prolific junior college career at Erie Community College where he played for head coach Alex Nwora, a Daemen graduate and inductee of the Daemen Hall of Fame. Harris brings a winning pedigree (47-17 record at ECC) and tremendous three-point shooting ability (166 three-pointers in the last two seasons) to the Wildcats. Big man <a href="Chris Luke">Chris Luke</a> (7'0", Jr., C) gives the Wildcats some depth at the center position and freshmen <a href="Keith Slack">Keith Slack</a> and <a href="Rayan Salzberg">Rayan Salzberg</a> will compete for minutes.

#### **GREAT ECC-XPECTATIONS**

For the first time since joining the East Coast Conference, the league's coaches have predicted a first-place finish for Daemen. The Wildcats sit atop the 2019-20 ECC preseason poll which was released in late October, Daemen amassed 80 total points in the poll. grabbing eight of nine first-place votes. St. Thomas Aquinas College picked up the remaining first-place vote, finishing with 72 points in the poll to sit at No. 2. The University of Bridgeport (64 points) and defending ECC tournament champion Molloy College (53 points) round out the top four teams. Daemen holds an 87-27 all-time record in ECC contests dating back to the 2013-14 season. Only St. Thomas Aguinas (89-24) holds more wins in ECC games during that time frame. The Wildcats have finished third or better in all six seasons since joining the league.

# NORTHWEST MISSOURI STATE SCOUTING REPORT

Head coach Ben McCollum has presided over one of the top NCAA Division II programs in the country, posting a 241-75 overall record over his first 10 seasons at Northwest Missouri State. The Bearcats compete as members of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, and are ranked No. 1 in the NABC preseason top-25 poll following a perfect 38-0 campaign that culminated last spring with their 64-58 defeat of Point Loma in the national championship game. It marked NMSU's second national title in the last three years as they've posted a 100-5 record in that span. At the conference level, McCollum has led the Bearcats to six consecutive MIAA regular-season championships and four straight MIAA tournament crowns. Gone from last season's championship team is All-American and MIAA Player of the Year Joey Witthus (21.1 ppg), but the Bearcats bring back seven letterwinners, including four starters. That group is headlined by sophomore guard Trevor Hudgins (2018-19 MIAA Freshman of the Year, first-team All-MIAA) and junior forward Ryan Hawkins (MIAA Defensive Player of the Year, second-team All-MIAA). Hudgins shot 53% from the field and 46% from three-point range (72 three-pointers) while averaging 18.7 points per game. He also totaled 203 assists (5th nationally) and helped NMSU rank second nationally in assist/turnover ratio (1.78). Hawkins was stellar at both ends of the floor, averaging 13.9 points and a team-high 8.9 rebounds per game, while canning 81 three-pointers. He ranked seventh in the country with 83 steals. Incumbent starters Diego Bernard (Soph., G) and Ryan Welty (Sr., F) also return for the Bearcats. Not only did NSMU rattle of 38 straight wins, but they did so in dominant fashion; they're 20.7 scoring margin ranked first in the country, and they held opponents to just 61.7 points per game, third-best in the country. The Bearcats featured the three-point shot

a lot last season, launching 988 attempts from downtown (5th in the country). They ranked 22nd in made three-pointers per game (10.6) and ninth in three-point field goal percentage (40.6) among the national leaders. They also ranked sixth in overall field goal percentage (51.1). The Bearcats played Duke to a six-point game (69-63) in their only exhibition contest last Saturday. Hudgins nailed seven three-pointers and scored a game-high 27 points.

#### TUNE-UPS

In preparation for the 2019-20 regular season, Daemen played a trio of exhibition contests, including two against highly-touted Division I programs Buffalo and Syracuse. Despite having just seven days of practice under their belt, Daemen opened the brief exhibition season with a 111-73 loss against a Buffalo team that spent the majority of the 2018-19 season ranked among the top-25 teams in the country, finishing the year with a 32-4 overall record and a trip to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Less than 48 hours later the Wildcats made their first-ever appearance at the iconic Carrier Dome on the campus of SU, falling to the Orange and legendary head coach Jim Boeheim 90-71. It left as a decent a feeling as one can have following a 19-point defeat at the Wildcats played SU even (43-43) over the final 20 minutes. The exhibition slate wrapped up on Oct. 29 with Daemen blasting Mohawk (116-54) out of the Ontario Colleges Athletic Association. Andrew Sischo led the Wildcats by averaging 18.3 points and 10.3 rebounds over the three contests. He put up 28 points and 12 rebounds against Buffalo, numbers that no player has achieved against the Bulls in the last three seasons, and followed up with another

double-double (15 points, 12 rebounds) at Syracuse. <u>Breon Harris</u> netted a team-high 23 points at the Carrier Dome, and finished the exhibition slate averaging 10.7 points per game. Newcomer <u>Joey Wallace</u> also made his presence felt, averaging 10.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.3 assists per game.

#### **FIRST THINGS FIRST**

Daemen will bring a 17-game winning streak in regularseason openers into Friday's contest vs. Northwest Missouri State. The wins in that span have come over 14 different opponents. Fisher (Mass.), Wilfrid Laurier (Ont.) and Caldwell are the only opponents Daemen has defeated twice in season openers during the streak. The Wildcats' average margin of victory during the streak is an astonishing 23.8 points per game; in the team's six season openers since beginning to play a full Division II schedule, the average margin of victory is 18.2 points per game. Just two games - a 68-65 final over Toronto in 2011, and a 62-57 final over Felician in 2017 - have been decided by single digits. Daemen has gone over 100 points in three of the last seven season openers; the highwater mark came in 2013 when they downed Ohio Valley 111-90. Daemen's last loss in a season opener came at the Spring Hill College (Ala.) Tournament against the hosts on Nov. 2, 2001, falling 75-35.

#### **Weekly Poll Notes:**

Defending national champion Northwest Missouri State is atop the NABC/Division II pre-season for the second time in three years and in both cases, it comes after winning the previous year's national championship. Northwest is the only school to hold the top ranking in the pre-season poll after winning a national title over the last eight years.

A total of 60 schools received votes in the pre-season poll and all 23 NCAA Division II conferences have at least one of its teams listed either among the top 25 or receiving votes.

The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association and South Atlantic Conference have two teams apiece in the top 10 (Northwest Missouri State and Missouri Southern from the MIAA; Lincoln Memorial and Queens, N.C., from the SAC), while the expanded Lone Star Conference is the only conference with three in the top 25 (West Texas A&M, St. Edward's and Tarleton State).

Six of the eight schools in last year's Elite Eight are among the teams listed in the pre-season top 25. National finalist Point Loma was among those that received votes.

With Northwest Missouri State and Nova Southeastern holding the top two spots in the pre-season poll, it marks the 13<sup>th</sup> time since the 1996-97 season – the first year in which a pre-season poll was produced – that the top two ranked teams had played in the previous year's Elite Eight. The last time was prior to the 2016-17 season with West Liberty and Lincoln Memorial.

A total of 14 schools that were in last year's pre-season top 25 are also in this year's. Bellarmine is listed in the pre-season rankings for the 11<sup>th</sup> straight season, while West Liberty is among that group for a 10<sup>th</sup> straight year. Meanwhile, Nova Southeastern, Ashland, St. Edward's, Daemen and Concordia (Calif.) are in the pre-season rankings for the first time ever.

Six teams in the pre-season poll will be in action on the first day of competition on Friday, including No. 1 Northwest Missouri State against No. 22 Daemen and No. 6 West Texas A&M facing No. 7 Lincoln Memorial in the Hall of Fame Classic in St. Joseph, Mo.




