## > FASTBREAK POINTS

- 1. It's an all East Coast Conference final round of the NCAA Division II East Regional as second-seeded Daemen meets top-seeded St. Thomas Aquinas for the right to advance to the Elite Eight. Daemen is in the regional final for the first time, while STAC has advanced this far three times now in the last four seasons. The Spartans won the region and went to the Elite Eight in 2017.
- 2. Daemen advanced to Tuesday's regional final with an 81-69 victory over third-seeded Bloomfield late Sunday evening. All five starters scored in double figures, led by redshirt senior center *Andrew Sischo's* 25 points. The Wildcats shot better than 50% from the field, 40% from the three-point line and 75% from the free throw line for the third time this season en route to the program's first ever NCAA tournament victory.
- 3. St. Thomas Aquinas advanced to the regional final with a 95-72 victory earlier Sunday over fifth-seeded Caldwell. **Osbel Caraballo** (24 points in 20 minutes) and **Grant Singleton** (17 points in 18 minutes) led the way. The Spartans employed their customary pressure defense to force Caldwell into 22 turnovers. The Spartans lead the country in turnovers forced per game (20.4) while ranking second in turnover margin (7.6) and third in steals (10.2).
- 4. Daemen and STAC will be meeting for the fourth time this season. The teams split two regular season meetings in late February. Daemen's 84-81 overtime victory on Feb. 27 snapped the Spartans' 13-game winning streak. STAC regrouped for a 71-68 win the following day, and defeated Daemen one week later, 83-67, to claim their fifth ECC tournament championship in the last six seasons. Tuesday's meeting marks the sixth postseason meeting between Daemen and STAC their first in the NCAA tournament.

## > ST. THOMAS AQUINAS SCOUTING REPORT

- St. Thomas Aquinas has been among the best NCAA Division II programs in recent years. From 2015-16 through 2019-20, the Spartans averaged 26.2 wins per season and won four of five ECC tournament championships. They've earned six straight NCAA tournament berths and enter Tuesday's regional final with a 14-1 record and ranked in both national polls.
- > Head coach Tobin Anderson has been the catalyst for STAC's rise, leading the Spartans to 181 wins since taking over in 2013-14. No Division II team in New York State or in the ECC has won more games in that time.
- > The Spartans return eight players, including four starters, from their 2019-20 team that went 25-5.
- > Junior forward **Osbel Caraballo** and junior guard **Demetre Roberts** headline the Spartan returners after earning All-ECC first team honors last season when they combined for 32.5 points per game.
- ➤ Both Caraballo (16.3 ppg, 7.5 rpg) and Roberts (14.5 ppg, 4.6 apg) are producing again this season, while junior guard **Grant Singleton** has emerged as well. Singleton is the only player in the ECC 6-foot or smaller shooting better than 50% from the field (53.3%). He has made a team-high 33 three-point field goals (on 39.3% shooting) and is averaging a team-high 17.3 points per game up from his 10.9 average last season.
- > The Spartans have also been boosted by senior guard **Elijah Bovell**, a transfer from Queens, and freshman guard **Jamal Barnes** who are both producing 7.1 points per game.
- Additional production is coming from senior guard **Louis Griffith** (8.3 ppg, 37.7% 3PT), and senior forward **Kevin Lynch** (6.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg). Lynch was named the ECC Co-Defensive Player of the Year in the ECC.
- > STAC has employed its customary pressure defense this season, forcing opponents into 20.1 turnovers per game best in Division II. The Spartans also rank third in steals per game (10.2) and their defense fuels an offense that is producing 90.8 points per contest.



# DAEMEN MEN'S BASKETBALL AWARDED NCAA TOURNAMENT BID

Wildcats are number two seed in East Region, receive by einto regional semifinals

AMHERST, N.Y. - Daemen has earned its third straight berth in the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division II Men's Basketball Championship. The Wildcats have been awarded an at-large bid to the 2021 NCAA tournament which gets underway next weekend with regional tournaments across the country. The full 48-team NCAA tournament bracket was announced late this evening during a selection show broadcast on NCAA.com.

The tournament field is broken down into eight regions, consisting of six teams each. Daemen is the No. 2 seed in the East Regional, which will take place at the Albany

The region's top two seeds both hail form the East Coast Conference. St. Thomas Aquinas, the ECC tournament champion, is the No. 1 seed in the region. STAC and Daemen will both receive first-round byes into the regional semifinals. The four remaining seeds are all members of the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference. Third-seeded Bloomfield will meet sixth-seeded Nyack in one of the quarterfinals, while the other quarterfinal will feature fourth-seeded Dominican (N.Y.) and fifth-seeded Caldwell.

The CACC did not have a conference championship tournament this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Bloomfield was declared the conference champion based on regular-season results. The East Region's other league, the Northeast-10 Conference, is not represented in the regional. Eleven of the NE-10's 14 schools opted not to play this season.

Daemen will face the Bloomfield/Nyack winner in the semifinals, while STAC will square off against the Dominican/Caldwell winner.

Quarterfinal games will take place Saturday, March 13. The regional semifinals will follow on Sunday, March 14, and the regional championship game is set for Tuesday, March 16. Game times and broadcast information for the East Region Championship will be announced later this week.

Daemen, which also earned at-large bids to the 2019 and 2020 NCAA tournaments, is back in the field after posting an 8-5 record so far this season. The Wildcats went 7-2 in ECC play and advanced to the championship game of the ECC tournament following a 78-72 victory over Roberts Wesleyan in Friday's semifinal round. Daemen's quest for a first-ever ECC tournament title came to an end following an 83-67 loss at top-seeded and nationally-ranked St. Thomas Aquinas earlier today.

The Wildcats made their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Championship in 2019 and suffered an opening round loss to New Haven. Daemen was scheduled to take on top-seeded Bridgeport in the opening round of last year's tournament, but the COVID-19 pandemic forced the cancellation of the tournament.

Bloomfield enters the tournament with a 6-3 record, including a 65-63 win over Nyack. If Bloomfield advances to the semifinals it will mark the first-ever meeting between Bloomfield and Daemen. Nyack stands at 4-4 on the year. Daemen and Nyack have met each of the last three seasons during the ECC-CACC Challenge hosted by the Wildcats. Daemen prevailed in each of those three meetings, including an 80-74 victory last year.

Winners of the eight regional tournaments will advance to the Elite Eight which is slated for March 24-27 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana.

#### HOW SWEET IT IS! WILDCATS ADVANCE TO EAST REGIONAL FINAL

Second-seeded Daemen dominates third-seeded Bloomfield in 81-69 win

ALBANY, N.Y. - For the first time in program history, the Daemen men's basketball team will compete for an NCAA Division II regional championship. Daemen, the No. 2 seed in the East Region, dispatched of third-seeded Bloomfield 81-69 tonight at the Albany Capital Center. The win pushes the Wildcats into the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Championship where they'll meet top-seeded St. Thomas Aquinas in the final round of the East Regional Tuesday.

It marked the first ever NCAA tournament victory for the Wildcats as they improve to 9-5 this season. Daemen has earned three consecutive NCAA tournament berths. The Wildcats made their NCAA tournament debut in 2019, falling in the opening round to fourth-seeded New Haven. Last season's tournament was called off due to the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic; the announcement was made as Daemen was en route to their opening round game in Bridgeport, Conn.

Bloomfield, which had advanced into tonight's regional semifinal with a 71-58 victory over sixth-seeded Nyack last evening, ended its season with a 7-4 record. Tonight's loss snapped a five-game winning streak for the Bears who were awarded an automatic bid to the tournament after finishing as the regular season champion from the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference. The Bears were making their ninth NCAA tournament appearance in the 19-tenure of head coach Gerald Holmes.

#### **IMPACT PLAYERS**

- All five Daemen starters reached double figures, led by redshirt senior center <u>Andrew Sischo</u> (Guilderland N.Y.) who scored a game-high 25 points on 11-of-15 shooting. It was a homecoming of sorts for the Daemen big man who grew up just over 10 miles away. He grabbed 10 boards to record his 11th double-double of the season, and equaled his season-high with three assists.
- Graduate student Sean Fasoyiro (Houston, Texas) scored 11 of his 14 points in the second half, and added seven rebounds and two steals.
- Senior guard <u>Kyle Harris</u> (Buffalo, N.Y.), sophomore guard <u>Ryan Salzberg</u> (Manlius, N.Y.) and freshman guards <u>Andrew Mason</u> (Webster, N.Y.) and <u>Juston Johnson</u> (Buffalo, N.Y.) accounted for eight of Daemen's nine three-pointers. Harris (12), Salzberg (10) and Mason (10) all hit double figures, while Johnson scored eight points off the bench, all in the first half.
- Bloomfield racked up 45 points off their bench, led by Izaiah Poole and Tony Godwin who scored 17 and 16, respectively. Rich Chapman chipped in with nine points.
- Isaiah Sparks was the lone Bloomfield starter to reach double digits, finishing with 13 points.

First Half (Daemen 42, Bloomfield 29) - Daemen led for more than 18 minutes in the opening stanza, taking advantage of a favorable matchup inside as Sischo scored 16 points on 8-of-11 shooting in the period. Johnson came off the bench to spark the Wildcats midway through the period, knocking down a pair of three-pointers and converting a steal into an easy layup during a 10-5 spurt. After going to the under-eight-minute media timeout leading 26-22, Daemen emerged with another 9-2 run and ultimately outscored the Bears 15-7 in the remainder of the period. Sischo scored six straight points to push the Wildcat lead to its widest margin at 41-26, before Daemen took a 13-point edge into the break.

**Second Half (Bloomfield 40, Daemen 39)** - Bloomfield started the half strong, scoring 15 points in less than five minutes to cut the Daemen lead to 51-44. Back-to-back buckets by Fasoyiro sparked Daemen's signature run of the game, a 14-0 spurt that put the Wildcats firmly in front. Fasoyiro netted seven points in the run which was capped by a corner three-pointer from Mason that extended Daemen's lead to 65-44 with 12:06 to play. The Wildcats stayed comfortably ahead for the duration. The lead reached 26 points (76-50) on Harris' three-pointer at the 7:07 mark. Bloomfield closed the game with an 13-3 run spanning the final 3:59.

#### INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- Daemen was firing on all cylinders offensively throughout much of the contest, shooting 29-for-55 from the field (52.7%), 9-for-21 from three-point range (42.9%) and 14-for-18 at the charity stripe (77.8%). It's the third time this season the Wildcats have shot at least 50% from the field, 40% from downtown and 75% from the free throw line in the same game.
- Playing their second game in as many nights, Bloomfield did not find sustained success at the offensive end. The Bears shot just 38% overall (27-for-71) and 25% from behind the three-point arc (7-for-28).
- Daemen collected 38 rebounds to Bloomfield's 33. Despite having only one starter taller than 6-foot-3, the Wildcats entered the game ranked ninth nationally with a +8.6 average rebounding margin.

#### **GAME NOTES**

- Tonight's game featured two of the top coaches in the East Region. With 395 wins in 24 seasons, Daemen's <u>Mike MacDonald</u> ranks sixth among active East Region coaches for career wins. Bloomfield's Gerald Holmes ranks ninth with 344.
- It marked the first ever meeting between Daemen and Bloomfield. Daemen has now won 14 consecutive games against CACC opponents. Since joining the ECC in 2013-14, Daemen is 18-3 against CACC teams.
- Sischo entered the game ranked third in scoring and first in rebounding among the Division II national leaders. He's averaging 26.8 points and 12.8 rebounds per game, and has now scored 20 points or more in 12 of his 13 games this season and in 57 games during his career. Sischo has scored 10 or more points in 64 straight games.
- Already Daemen's all-time leading scorer Sischo has totaled 2,169 points and 1,072 rebounds. He trails ECC record-holder Justin Reyes (St. Thomas Aquinas) by 78 points for the all-time conference scoring record. He is 31 rebounds shy of Daemen's all-time mark held by Hall of Famer Alex Nwora, and tonight moved into a tie with St. Rose's Garth Joseph for third place on the ECC's all-time rebounding list.
- Mason has scored in double figures in nine straight games, averaging 15.7 points in that span. For the season, the rookie guard is producing 13.4 points, 6.7 rebounds and 3.5 assists per contest while shooting 55% overall and 47% from three-point territory.
- Daemen has won seven of their last nine games. Their only two losses in that span are to Tuesday's opponent, St. Thomas Aquinas.
- Daemen and STAC split two regular season meetings in late February the fifth time that's happened in the last six seasons. STAC drew last blood with an 83-67 victory in the final round of the ECC Championship last weekend. The Wildcats and Spartans have met 17 times since the start of the 2014-15 season, including five conference tournament matchups.
- Daemen is coming off back-to-back 24-win seasons that resulted in NCAA tournament berths. Daemen's 89 wins from 2016-17 through 2019-20 represents the most successful four-year span in program history. The Wildcats were hit hard by graduation, losing four of their five starters, all of whom were 1,000-point scorers.

#### **NEXT JUMP BALL**

Daemen and St. Thomas Aquinas meet for the fourth time this season, tipping off Tuesday's (March 16) regional championship game at 7 p.m. from the Albany Capital Center. The winner of Tuesday's game advances to the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Elite Eight which is set for March 24-27 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind.

# MIKE MACDONALD HEAD COACH • SEVENTH SEASON • ST. BONAVENTURE, '88

A fixture in the college basketball coaching fraternity, Mike MacDonald has been roaming sidelines, mentoring players and giving the occasional earful to referees for the last 32 years, all within Western New York. With previous stops at Canisius College and Medaille College, MacDonald has worked across all three NCAA divisions, racking up nearly 400 victories in 23 seasons as a head coach. His coaching success aside, MacDonald's personable nature and his willingness to give back to the local community have made him one of the most highly thought of people in the WNY sports community.

The 2020-21 season marks MacDonald's seventh at Daemen. Since being <u>introduced as the sixth head coach</u> in the modern history of the program, MacDonald has guided the Wildcats to a 129-51 overall record, an East Coast Conference (ECC) regular season championship and two NCAA tournament berths. Daemen ranks second for total wins among New York State's Division II programs since MacDonald came to Main Street.

The veteran bench boss has presided over Daemen's emergence as a power within the NCAA Division II East Region, a period that's been one of the most successful in program history. The team's 89 wins from the start of the 2016-17 season through the 2019-20 campaign is tied for the most in any four-year stretch dating back to the 1986-87 season. More than half of those wins have come in the last two seasons as MacDonald has led Daemen to back-to-back 24-win campaigns, setting the benchmark for victories during the program's NCAA Division II era. Since the start of the 2018-19 season, the Wildcats have spent a combined 29 weeks ranked in top-25 national polls conducted by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA), rising as high as No. 8 in both. Daemen has also been ranked in 29 successive D2SIDA regional polls dating back to January of 2018.

The positive momentum has led to numerous opportunities not otherwise afforded to teams from similar institutions, with MacDonald playing a central role. In recent years, MacDonald has taken teams to play exhibition contests against Division I opponents such as Buffalo, Siena and Syracuse. The Wildcats were invited participants at the prestigious Small College Basketball National Hall of Fame Classic to start the 2019-20 season. Daemen also played their first-ever game at Downtown Buffalo's KeyBank Center on November 23, 2019, defeating Wilmington (Del.) in a thriller, 83-81. It was MacDonald's 18th win in the building - the most of any basketball coach in the venue's 24-year history.

After leading Daemen to the ECC regular season title with a 16-2 mark in conference play in 2018-19, MacDonald steered the team into the NCAA tournament for the first time as the Wildcats were awarded an at-large bid as the No. 5 seed in the East Region. Daemen made their NCAA tournament debut on March 16, 2019, falling to fourth-seeded New Haven in an opening round contest played in Manchester, N.H.

Buoyed by All-American Andrew Sischo, the Wildcats were set to return to the NCAA tournament in 2020, again garnering at-large consideration, this time as the No. 8 seed in the East Region. However, the COVID-19 pandemic caused the unprecedented cancellation of NCAA championships before the tournament got underway.

Milestones and accolades have poured in throughout MacDonald's tenure with the Wildcats. His 350th career win came in dramatic fashion on January 18, 2019 as junior guard Breon Harris scored five points in the final 21 seconds to lift the Wildcats past Mercy, 75-74. His 100th win at Daemen came just three weeks later, placing MacDonald among an elite fraternity of coaches who have achieved at least 100 wins while coaching in each of the NCAA's three divisions. That achievement propelled him to HoopDirt.com Division II Coach of the Week honors. MacDonald has also been recognized as a two-time Division II Coach of the Year from the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY), as well as receiving ECC and NABC District Coach of the Year (both for the 2018-19 season).

MacDonald's tenure got started with a bang. In his return to Canisius' Koessler Athletic Center on November 11, 2014, he led the Wildcats to an 83-81 overtime win against the Division I Golden Griffins, a program he led for nine seasons. His official Daemen debut came just days later as his Wildcats walloped Concordia (N.Y.), 88-50, in the opening round of the ECC-CACC Challenge. It served as a precursor to future success as the Wildcats have posted an 11-1 mark in the ECC-CACC Challenge with MacDonald at the helm.

Later that season, MacDonald helped the Wildcats achieve postseason success despite the loss of two starters to season-ending injuries. With Daemen still ineligible for ECC and NCAA Division II postseason, Daemen elected to partake in the United States Collegiate Athletic Association (USCAA)

Division I National Championships in Uniontown, Pa., entering the tournament as the No. 1 overall seed. While there, MacDonald guided Daemen to wins over No. 8 Indiana-South Bend (69-63), No. 4 Concordia (Ala.) (68-63) and No. 3 Rochester (Mich.) (77-53) to capture the program's first USCAA national title, riding USCAA Division I Player of the Year and National Championships MVP Gerald Beverly to the tourney crown.

In the 2015-16 season - Daemen's first as a full-fledged NCAA Division II member - MacDonald's squad hit their stride after the calendar turned to January, scoring 15 wins in the final 19 games of the regular season. Included in the string was a miraculous 98-96 win over rival Roberts Wesleyan as the Wildcats erased a 22-point deficit over the final six minutes of the contest. After finishing with a 14-6 record in conference play, the Wildcats made their ECC tournament debut with a 103-102 overtime win over Mercy in the semifinals.

Daemen has finished third or better in the ECC standings in each of MacDonald's fist six seasons. They've qualified for the conference tournament in each of the five years they've been eligible, advancing to at least the semifinals every season and to the finals in 2016. MacDonald has also played a direct role in mentoring 10 players who account for 18 all-conference selections.

Home court success has been a large part of the program's success through the years, including the MacDonald Era. The Wildcats won their first nine home games under MacDonald, extending the program's Lumsden Gymnasium winning streak to 44 straight games before it was snapped. The Wildcats have posted a 76-14 record in home games under MacDonald's guidance. They've set a new program benchmark for home wins in a season, posting identical 15-1 home records during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.

Before arriving at Daemen, MacDonald spent eight years (2006-14) leading the NCAA Division III program at Medaille where he transformed the Mavericks into a regional contender. Inheriting a program that went 4-46 in the two years prior to his arrival, MacDonald's version of the Mavericks averaged 18 wins per season, while advancing to the postseason six times.

Medaille's emergence as a Division III power in the Northeast was cemented in MacDonald's final five seasons there, as he led the Mavericks to more wins (101) than any other Division III team in New York State, while ranking 17th nationally in wins during the same time frame. MacDonald was named the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions (2006-07, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2011-12). He left as the school's all-time leader in wins (149) and winning percentage (.671).

Prior to his time at Medaille, MacDonald spent 18 years at Canisius, including a nine-year stint (1997-2006) as head coach. In that time, MacDonald guided the Golden Griffins to 108 wins which ranks him third in program history for coaching victories. While there, he was one of only five coaches in that program's storied history to orchestrate a 20-win season and was named the 2000-01 BCANY Division I Co-Coach of the Year.

Before being elevated to the head coaching post at Canisius, MacDonald worked as an assistant on the Griffs' coaching staff, first under Marty Marbach and later under John Beilein. As Beilein's top assistant, MacDonald helped Canisius reach the 1996 NCAA tournament in addition to two National Invitational Tournament appearances.

In addition to his coaching accomplishments, MacDonald brings a strong connection to the local community. His teams have been active with a number of community organizations in the greater Buffalo community and beyond, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Buffalo, Blessed Sacrament Athletic Club and Coaches vs. Cancer. In August of 2020, MacDonald received the Jim Satalin Inspiration Award from the American Cancer Society of Western New York in recognition of his dedication and work on behalf of the Coaches vs. Cancer program.

MacDonald and several of his players have also worked with the Drug Enforcement Administration and Mayor Byron Brown's office on Game Changers, a nationally awarded program that provides academic and athletic opportunities for inner-city youths during the summer months.

A 1988 graduate of Saint Bonaventure University, MacDonald additionally serves Daemen as the senior associate athletics director for external relations. He resides in Amherst with his wife, Maura (nee Heary). The couple has raised four children - Matthew, Patrick, Nicholas and Mark. Matthew served as team captain during his collegiate career at the University of Pennsylvania and is now a player development assistant with the Brooklyn Nets. Patrick was a Division III All-American while playing at the State University of New York Maritime College, and is now enlisted in the United States Navy. Nicholas is a sophomore on the basketball team at Niagara University, and Mark is a freshman attending Canisius High School.

- 5. Since the start of the 2013-14 season, STAC and Daemen rank first and second respectively in overall victories among all ECC teams. STAC's 181 wins in that span also rank first among all Division II teams in New York State, while Daemen's 159 wins ranks second. The two teams have also combined for nine NCAA tournament berths since 2016 (STAC 6, Daemen 3).
- 6. Redshirt senior center **Andrew Sischo** entered NCAA tournament play ranked third in scoring (27.0) and first in rebounding (13.0) among the Division II national leaders. Sischo is just the second player in ECC history to reach 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds and was named the ECC Player of the Year for the third time. He has scored 20+ points in 12 of 13 games this season (57 games in his career) and has reached double figures in 64 straight games.
- 7. Freshman guard **Andrew Mason** has hit double figures in nine straight games, averaging 15.7 points in that span. He was named to the ECC Championship all-tournament team after scoring 19 points and shooting 5-for-5 from three-point range in Daemen's final-round loss to STAC. For the season, Mason is contributing 13.4 points, 6.7 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game while shooting 55% overall (4th in ECC) and 47% from three-point range (3rd in ECC).

- 8. Daemen head coach *Mike MacDonald* stands just five wins shy of 400 for his career which has spanned nearly a quarter century. MacDonald is among an elite fraternity of coaches that have achieved 100 victories as a head coach at the Division I, II and III levels. He ranks 37th among active Division II coaches in career victories (sixth among East Region coaches). STAC's *Tobin Anderson* has totaled 366 wins in 20 seasons to rank 42nd on the same list (eighth among East Region coaches).
- 9. STAC enters the game ranked in both Division II national polls: #11 in the NABC Division II coaches poll and #5 in the D2SIDA national media poll. Daemen is receiving votes in the latest D2SIDa poll. Daemen has defeated STAC while they've been nationally ranked in four of the last five seasons.
- 10. **Andrew Sischo** is averaging 27.0 points and 10.7 rebounds in the three games vs. STAC this season. STAC has been led in the games by the trio of **Grant Singleton** (18.0 ppg), **Demetre Roberts** (18.0 ppg) and **Osbel Caraballo** (17.3 ppg). Singleton was named the Most Outstanding Player of the ECC tournament after totaling 20 points in STAC's final round victory.

#### **UNPRECEDENTED SEASON**

The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has wreaked havoc upon collegiate sports with postponements, pauses and cancelations. Daemen, which experienced its own 10-day pause in team activities due to a positive COVID-19 test result, was out of action for 328 days before making their long-awaited season debut on Jan. 29 vs. Gannon. Daemen competed in 11 regular season games, including nine ECC contests. The limited schedule was comprised with the health and safety of all players, coaches and other Tier 1 personnel in mind, and in accordance with COVID-19 guidelines established by the NCAA.

#### **SUSTAINED SUCCESS**

The Daemen program has been built on sustained success, winning at least 19 games in each of the last nine seasons. In that span (2011-20), which encompasses the end of Daemen's NAIA Era, its' NCAA transition period and the first five seasons of full NCAA Division II membership, the Wildcats won 70% of their contests, going 176-75. Looking more recently, Daemen went 70-22 in the last three seasons (.761 winning percentage), and their 89 wins in the last four seasons is the most successful four-year span in program history.

#### **GOING STREAKING**

Daemen has embarked on four winning streaks of at least nine games since the start of the 2018-19 season. Last season, the Wildcats put together an 11-game winning streak, covering games played Nov. 2 through Dec. 13 - the longest of Daemen's NCAA Era.

#### BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK

Daemen has earned a third consecutive NCAA tournament berth this season. The Wildcats won 24 games (NCAA Era program record) and earned at-large bids to the NCAA tournament in each of the two seasons prior. The team's 2019 bid was the first in program history, and the Wildcats made their NCAA tournament debut as the No. 5 seed in the East Region, falling in the opening round to fourth-seeded New Haven, 72-

67. Daemen was awarded the No. 8 seed in the East Region, however the tournament was canceled before it even began due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### **POLL POSITION**

Daemen has been among the nationally ranked teams for the third straight season. The Wildcats have been ranked as high as No. 21 in the Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA) national media poll and have also received votes in the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) top-25 poll this season. The Wildcats have been ranked 18 times in the D2SIDA poll dating back to the 2018-19 season, rising as high as No. 8, a position they held for three successive weeks early last season. In addition, the Wildcats have been ranked in 34 of the last 35 D2SIDA East Region media polls.

#### **WALKING THE STAGE**

Daemen was hit hard by graduation in 2020, losing starters **Breon Harris**, **Jay Sarkis**, **Jeff Redband** and **Joey Wallace** who were each 1,000-point scorers as well as All-ECC honorees at one point or another. Harris, Sarkis and Redband were well entrenched in the Wildcats' lineup, combining for 330 games and 297 starts in their respective careers, and played key roles in leading Daemen to 89 wins.

#### **VETERAN PRESENCE**

Daemen will turn to graduate transfer Sean Fasoyiro and senior guard Kyle Harris to provide a veteran presence on a relatively young roster. A 6-foot-3 guard, Fasoyiro appeared in 81 games over the last three seasons for Franklin Pierce, helping them to a 45-38 record. In 28 games last season, including eight starts, Fasoyiro produced career-highs in scoring (7.8 ppg), minutes (21.8 mpg), field goal percentage (45.7), three-point percentage (37.5), rebounding (5.0 rpg) and assists (1.3). The Wildcats have had success in recent years on the transfer market, getting successful one-year contributors such as Joey Wallace and Quinn Lee Yaw. Now in his second season with the program, Harris is Daemen's most experienced returning player after

center **Andrew Sischo**. Harris appeared in all 32 games and made nine starts last season when he shot 38% from three-point range and averaged 4.4 points per game.

#### **ALL-WNY PEDIGREE**

Mike MacDonald and his staff made a sizable dent in the available WNY talent pool by inking 6-foot guard Juston Johnson, 6-foot-6 forward Justin Hemphill and 5-foot-11 guard Tyler Hind in the program's 2020 recruiting class. Johnson and Hemphill represent the first All-WNY first team selections to commit to Daemen out of high school since Mark Coppola in 2010. Hind, a second team All-WNY brings a stellar resume of his own, including 2,244 points which ranks eighth all-time among WNY players. He also set a new WNY record with 400 three-pointers in his career and was named the New York State Class C Player of the Year as a senior.

#### 585 <del>→</del> 716

Daemen has had great success recruiting out of the Rochester area through the years. In fact, of the 11 Daemen players that have earned All-ECC honors since the 2013-14 season, eight of them have been products of Section V high schools. The Wildcats are hoping for continued production from the Rochester pipeline as freshmen guards **Andrew Mason** and **Tony Arnold** join the list of Section V standouts to choose Daemen. Both were All-Greater Rochester selections who graduated as the all-time leading scorers at their respective high schools. Arnold led the Eastridge, the same school that produced former Daemen guard Supreme Hannah, to their first sectional title in some 56 years last winter. Daemen has signed 11 All-Greater Rochester players since 2010.

### DEFENDING THE DEN

Success on their home floor has been a staple of Daemen's rise within the NCAA Division II ranks. The Wildcats have won 10+ home games in eight of the last nine seasons, including identical 15-1 records in the last two seasons which established a new program benchmark for homecourt victories. Dating back to the 2017-18 season, Daemen has won 42 of their last 46 home games. Since joining the ECC (2013-14 season), Daemen is 59-10 in home conference games (.855 win %). The Wildcats are also 70-13 at home during the program's NCAA era (.843 win %). In the 20 seasons from 2000-01 through 2019-20, the Wildcats won 83% of all home games, going 220-45.

#### **BIG MAN ON CAMPUS**

Redshirt senior center *Andrew Sischo*, the two-time East Coast Conference and East Region Player of the Year and a consensus All-American, headlines Daemen's returning players. Sischo has already cemented his place among Daemen's all-time great players by racking up 1,820 points, 906 rebounds and a program-record 722 field goals in his first three collegiate seasons. Sischo's 2019-20 season was one for the record books as well. He set Daemen and ECC records for points (773) and field goals (298) in a season, led the country in total rebounds (362) and double-doubles (22) and became the first Division II player since the 2010-11 season to average at least 24 points and 11 rebounds per game while shooting at least 64% from the field. He enters the season having scored 20+ points 45 times in his career, including a record 47-point outburst in the opening round of the ECC Championship tournament last March. Already this season, he's been named a Preseason All-American by Basketball Times, as well as the ECC Preseason Player of the Year - an honor he's now earned in three straight seasons.

### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE YOUR DELIGHTMENT**

Andrew Sischo has been a double-double machine throughout his career, racking up 58 of them in 102 games - the most for a Daemen player since Gerald Beverly totaled 46 double-doubles in his career spanning 2011-15. Since the start of his sophomore season, Sischo has recorded double-doubles in more than two-thirds of the games he's appeared in (50 double-doubles in 72 games). Sischo's

22 double-doubles in 2019-20 led all Division II players.

#### **BEST OF THE BEST**

During Daemen's game vs. Roberts Wesleyan on Feb. 11, 2021, *Andrew Sischo* became the program's all-time leading scorer, surpassing the benchmark of 1,962 points set by *Robert Robinson* (1988-92). In 102 career games, Sischo has totaled 2,169 points and 1,072 rebounds. He stands as the only player in program history and one of only two players in ECC history with at least 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. He is Daemen's and the ECC's all-time leader in field goals with 861. Sischo ranks second in Daemen history in rebounding, and has placed himself among impressive company within ECC history, ranking second in scoring and third in rebounding.

#### **OPTING OUT**

Daemen has had eight players exercise their right to opt out of the 2020-21 season due to COVID-19. These players include guard **Tajmin Holt**, forward Ryan Bradley and center Chris Luke who all saw regular minutes last season. Each player's decision has been fully supported by the Daemen coaching staff and athletics administration.

#### **UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY**

Daemen had won 17 consecutive season openers spanning 2002-18. That streak was snapped last season with their loss to No. 1 Northwest Missouri State. This season, back-to-back losses to Gannon put Daemen at 0-2 for the first time since the 2001-02 season.

#### **HEY ROOKIE**

Freshman guard **Andrew Mason** has twice earned ECC Rookie of the Week honors this season. Mason is the sixth Daemen player to be named ECC Rookie of the Week since the Wildcats joined the conference in 2013. Mason netted a career-high 25 points in Daemen's 103-69 win at D'Youville on Feb. 15 - the most for a Daemen freshman since the 2017-18 season when teammate **Andrew Sischo** posted a pair of 25+ point games.

#### A NEW STREAK

Daemen's 80-75 loss to Roberts Wesleyan on Feb. 11 snapped a series winning streak that had reached 20 games over a span of 10 years. It was the Redhawks' first win over Daemen since Feb. 15, 2011, and also their first home win in the series since Feb. 21, 2007. Daemen earned some redemption with an 85-69 win over RWC on Feb. 17 and a 78-72 triumph in the ECC Championship semifinals on Mar. 5. The Wildcats have won 29 of the last 31 meetings overall and 12 straight home meetings in the series.

#### **HAVE MERCY**

Daemen's 82-51 win over Mercy on Feb. 20 pushed the Wildcats to 16-0 all-time against the Mavericks. Their success in the series is tied for the program's longest active winning streak against any single opponent. Daemen has also won 16 straight meetings with former NAIA rival Houghton, but haven't met the Highlanders since the 2011-12 season.

#### **BUDDING BUFFALO RIVALRY**

After not playing since 2004, Daemen met crosstown rival D'Youville three times in as many weeks this season. The Wildcats posted wins in all three matchups, improving to 9-0 all-time in the series. D'Youville is in its first season as a member of the ECC as it transitions to NCAA Division II membership following a long history within Division III. With the two schools separated by less than 10 miles, the Daemen-D'Youville rivalry has the potential to be among the best in the ECC.

#### **MORE SISCHO**

By eclipsing 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, **Andrew Sischo** has joined an elite fraternity of East Region players to reach both milestones:

#### **INSTANT CLASSIC**

Daemen earned its most impressive win of the season on Feb. 2 by defeating #11/#5 St. Thomas Aquinas 84-81 in overtime. The Daemen win snapped STAC's 13-game winning streak and knocked the Spartans from the ranks of the unbeaten. **Sean Fasoyiro** scored off a miraculous feed from **Andrew Mason** to even the score at 71-71 with less than five seconds remaining in regulation. In the overtime period, **Ryan Salzberg** drilled back-to-back three-pointers inside of two minutes left to give Daemen the lead. **Andrew Sischo** logged 39 minutes - including the last 10 with four personal fouls - and totaled 28 points and 13 rebounds.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP QUEST**

Daemen's quest for an elusive ECC tournament title will have to wait for another season after they lost 83-67 to nationally ranked St. Thomas Aquinas in the 2021 title game at Aquinas Hall on Mar. 7. It marked Daemen's second appearance in the final round of the ECC Championship, and the first since 2016 when they also fell to the Spartans. STAC used a 21-6 spurt over the final six minutes of the first half to seize control. Their lead ballooned to 21 points in the second half before Daemen cut it to 11, but the Wildcats could get no closer.

#### A WIN WORTH WAITING FOR

Daemen earned the first NCAA tournament victory in program history, defeating third-seeded Caldwell in the regional semifinals on Mar. 14. The win came a year to the day after Daemen was supposed to play in the NCAA tournament vs. Bridgeport before the 2020 event was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Wildcats, who made their NCAA tournament debut in 2019, have earned postseason bids in three successive seasons.
