JUMP BALL

Daemen makes its return to the hardwood Thursday night with a non-conference clash against nationally ranked Mercyhurst. The Wildcats have been idle since returning from a season-opening three-game trip to Texas for the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic. Daemen was forced to go into a COVID-19-related pause of team activities which resulted in the cancelation of two exhibition games (vs. Buffalo and Medaille) as well as the East Region Challenge tournament which was slated for this past weekend at Lumsden Gymnasium. They'll look to get back on track against a Mercyhurst team that won its opening two games by an average of 28.5 points.

RELOADED

Daemen returns 11 players, including all five starters, from their regional championship team - players responsible for 98% of scoring, 99% of rebounding and assists from a season ago. None is bigger, both literally and figuratively, than center Andrew Sischo who returns for a fifth collegiate season after averaging 26.9 points and 13.0 rebounds per game last season. Fellow All-ECC picks Sean Fasoyiro (13.9 ppg, 7.1 rpg, 3.9 apg) and Kyle Harris (12.5 ppg, 39% 3PT) also return, along with Ryan Salzberg (8.6 ppg, 36% 3PT) and Andrew Mason (12.6 ppg, 6.1 rpg, 49% 3PT).

A MAGICAL RUN

The Wildcats earned their third consecutive NCAA tournament berth and captured their first regional title last March. After entering the tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional, the Wildcats ran to an 81-69 win over third-seeded Bloomfield in the regional semifinals, marking the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. The Wildcats followed up with a 71-70 defeat of top-seeded St. Thomas Aquinas in the regional final, avenging a loss just nine days prior in the ECC Championship final. Andrew Sischo was named the Most Outstanding Player of the East Regional after netting 25 points and grabbing 13 rebounds in the final. The Wildcats' run came to an end just over a week later in Evansville, Indiana where they suffered a 97-83 loss in the Elite Eight to top-seeded and eventual national runner-up West Texas A&M. The Wildcats finished with a 10-6 overall record and were ranked ninth in the final D2SIDA national media poll.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

Graduate student Andrew Sischo is arguably the most decorated Daemen student-athlete of all-time. He entered his final collegiate season as the active scoring (2,223) and rebounding (1,101) leader among all NCAA Division II players. A two-time consensus All-American, Sischo is coming off

his finest season to date as he averaged career-highs in scoring (26.9 ppg - a Daemen single season record) and rebounding (13.0 rpg). Sischo scored 20+ points in 14 of 15 games last season and has scored 10+ points in 68 of his last 69 games. He has 62 double-doubles in 107 career games and has led Division II in double-doubles in each of the last two seasons. Sischo was named the East Conference Preseason Player of the Year for an unprecedented fourth time.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

Andrew Sischo recently surpassed a pair of milestones, adding to his collection of career achievements. In Daemen's season opener vs. Minnesota State Moorhead, Sischo became Daemen's all-time leading rebounder, supplanting Alex Nwora who had 1,103 rebounds in his career from 1989-93. The following night against Colorado Mesa, Sischo became the all-time leading scorer in East Coast Conference history, breaking the benchmark of 2,247 points set by former St. Thomas Aquinas star Justin Reyes from 2014-18. Sischo became Daemen's all-time scoring leader last season and is the first player in program history to reach 2,000 points. He is only the second player in ECC history (Reyes) with 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, and he already holds Daemen and ECC records for career field goals (900). He needs just seven rebounds to pass Reyes for second in ECC history.

RETURN OF THE MAC

Mike MacDonald returns for his eighth season on Daemen's bench and his 25th overall as a collegiate head coach. The veteran mentor has led Daemen to a 140-59 record since taking the reins in 2014. The Wildcats rank second in victories among all East Coast Conference and New York State Division II teams in that span. MacDonald is among an elite fraternity of coaches to have achieved 100 victories across all three NCAA divisions, and he enters the season just four wins shy of 400 for his career.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Daemen's most high-profile roster addition came in the form of 6-foot-5 guard Nick MacDonald, the son of head coach Mike MacDonald, who elected to transfer after two seasons at Division I Niagara. The younger MacDonald provides another three-point shooting option to an already potent team. The Wildcats ranked second in the ECC and 32nd nationally last season by averaging 9.6 made three-pointers per game. MacDonald shot 35% from deep and connected on 50 three-pointers in his two seasons with the Purple Eagles.



MERCYHURST SCOUTING REPORT

Mercyhurst is a member of the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference and the Lakers are led by veteran head coach Gary Manchel. Now in his 19th season with the program, Manchel has led the Lakers to a 310-190 record. The Lakers have earned three straight NCAA tournament berths, and five in the last seven seasons. Manchel has coached seven Laker teams that finished in the top 10 nationally for scoring defense, including their 2020-21 team that allowed 57.2 points per game (second in NCAA Division II).

The Lakers return 12 players from last season's squad that advanced to the Atlantic Regional semifinal and finished with a 12-1 record. Five of their top seven scorers are among the returners, headlined by senior guard MiyKah McIntosh who averaged a team-high 14.0 points per game last season. Mercyhurst was one of only three PSAC teams to compete during the 2020-21 season as the majority of the league opted out due to COVID-19.

Expectations are high as the Lakers have been ranked in both preseason national polls (No. 12 NABC; No. 21 D2SIDA). The PSAC coaches have also selected Mercyhurst to finish second in the PSAC West Division this season.

The Lakers opened with a pair of lopsided wins at the Dave Russell Conference Challenge hosted by Shepherd this past weekend. They blew the doors off Bowie State, winning 96-56, and added 77-60 defeat of Fayetteville State. Senior guard Steve Cannady is off to a fast start, averaging a team-high 17.5 points per game. McIntosh is chipping in 12.0 points per outing while newcomer Aidan Reichert is getting 11.0 points per game.

MIKE MACDONALD

HEAD COACH • EIGHTH SEASON • ST. BONAVENTURE, '88

A fixture in the college basketball coaching fraternity, Mike MacDonald has been roaming sidelines, mentoring players and giving the occasional earful to referees for the last 33 years, all within Western New York. With previous stops at Canisius College and Medaille College, MacDonald has worked across all three NCAA divisions, racking up nearly 400 victories in 24 seasons as a head coach. His coaching success aside, MacDonald's personable nature and his willingness to give back to the local community have made him one of the most highly thought of people in the WNY sports community.

The 2021-22 season marks MacDonald's eighth at Daemen. Since being [introduced as the sixth head coach](#) in the modern history of the program, MacDonald has guided the Wildcats to a 139-57 overall record, an East Coast Conference (ECC) regular season championship, three NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 NCAA Division II East Region championship. Daemen ranks second for total wins among New York State's Division II programs since MacDonald came to Main Street.

The veteran bench boss has presided over Daemen's emergence as a power within the NCAA Division II East Region, a period that's been one of the most successful in program history. The team's 89 wins from the start of the 2016-17 season through the 2019-20 campaign is tied for the most in any four-year stretch dating back to the 1986-87 season. More than half of those wins came during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons as MacDonald led Daemen to back-to-back 24-win campaigns, setting the benchmark for victories during the program's NCAA Division II era. Since the start of the 2018-19 season, the Wildcats have spent a combined 33 weeks ranked in top-25 national polls conducted by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA), rising as high as No. 8 in both.

The positive momentum has led to numerous opportunities not otherwise afforded to teams from similar institutions, with MacDonald playing a central role. In recent years, MacDonald has taken teams to play exhibition contests against Division I opponents such as Buffalo, Siena and Syracuse. The Wildcats were invited participants at the prestigious Small College Basketball National Hall of Fame Classic to start the 2019-20 season. Daemen also played their first-ever game at Downtown Buffalo's KeyBank Center on November 23, 2019, defeating Wilmington (Del.) in a thriller, 83-81. It was MacDonald's 18th win in the building - the most of any basketball coach in the venue's history.

After leading Daemen to the ECC regular season title with a 16-2 mark in conference play in 2018-19, MacDonald steered the team into the NCAA tournament for the first time as the Wildcats were awarded an at-large bid as the No. 5 seed in the East Region. Daemen made their NCAA tournament debut on March 16, 2019, falling to fourth-seeded New Haven in an opening round contest played in Manchester, N.H.

Buoyed by All-American Andrew Sischo, the Wildcats were set to return to the NCAA tournament in 2020, again garnering at-large consideration, this time as the No. 8 seed in the East Region. However, the COVID-19 pandemic caused the unprecedented cancellation of NCAA championships before the tournament got underway.

As the pandemic continued to wreak havoc on the world of intercollegiate athletics in 2020-21, MacDonald prepped his team for a return to competition. It ended up being a historic season for the Wildcats who finished 10-6 overall and ranked No. 9 in the final D2SIDA national poll. It marked the first time in Daemen's NCAA era that the program had finished a season ranked among the top 25 teams in the country. After opening the season with back-to-back losses, MacDonald guided the group to wins in seven of their final nine regular season contests, and ultimately advanced to the final round of the ECC Championship for the first time since 2016. After falling to rival St. Thomas Aquinas in the conference tournament final, the Wildcats were awarded a third consecutive at-large bid to the NCAA tournament, entering as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional. MacDonald led the Wildcats to their first-ever NCAA tournament win, an 81-69 dispatching of third-seeded Bloomfield on March 14. Two nights later they avenged their earlier loss to St. Thomas Aquinas, winning 71-70 against the region's No. 1 seed to claim the East Region title. Daemen advanced to the Elite Eight where they fell against top-seeded West Texas A&M at the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind.

Milestones and accolades have poured in throughout MacDonald's tenure with the Wildcats. His 350th career win came in dramatic fashion on January 18, 2019 as junior guard Breon Harris scored five points in the final 21 seconds to lift the Wildcats past Mercy, 75-74. His 100th win at Daemen came just three weeks later, placing MacDonald among an elite fraternity of coaches who have achieved at least 100 wins while coaching in each of the NCAA's three divisions. That achievement propelled him to HoopDirt.com Division II Coach of the Week honors. MacDonald has also been recognized as a two-time Division II Coach of the Year from the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY), as well as receiving ECC and NABC District Coach of the Year (both for the 2018-19 season). He enters the 2021-22 season ranked 37th among active Division II head coaches for career victories.

MacDonald's tenure got started with a bang. In his return to Canisius' Koessler Athletic Center on November 11, 2014, he led the Wildcats to an 83-81 overtime win against the Division I Golden Griffins, a program he led for nine seasons.

His official Daemen debut came just days later as his Wildcats walloped Concordia (N.Y.), 88-50, in the opening round of the ECC-CACC Challenge. It served as a precursor to future success as the Wildcats have posted an 11-1 mark in the ECC-CACC Challenge with MacDonald at the helm.

Later that season, MacDonald helped the Wildcats achieve postseason success despite the loss of two starters to season-ending injuries. With Daemen still ineligible for ECC and NCAA Division II postseason, Daemen elected to partake in the United States Collegiate Athletic Association (USCAA) Division I National Championships in Uniontown, Pa., entering the tournament as the No. 1 overall seed. While there, MacDonald guided Daemen to wins over No. 8 Indiana-South Bend (69-63), No. 4 Concordia (Ala.) (68-63) and No. 3 Rochester (Mich.) (77-53) to capture the program's first USCAA national title, riding USCAA Division I Player of the Year and National Championships MVP Gerald Beverly to the tourney crown.

In the 2015-16 season - Daemen's first as a full-fledged NCAA Division II member - MacDonald's squad hit their stride after the calendar turned to January, scoring 15 wins in the final 19 games of the regular season. Included in the string was a miraculous 98-96 win over rival Roberts Wesleyan as the Wildcats erased a 22-point deficit over the final six minutes of the contest. After finishing with a 14-6 record in conference play, the Wildcats made their ECC tournament debut with a 103-102 overtime win over Mercy in the semifinals.

Daemen has finished third or better in the ECC standings in each of MacDonald's first six seasons. They've qualified for the conference tournament in each of the five years they've been eligible, advancing to at least the semifinals every season and to the finals in 2016. MacDonald has also played a direct role in mentoring 10 players who account for 18 all-conference selections.

Home court success has been a large part of the program's success through the years, including the MacDonald Era. The Wildcats won their first nine home games under MacDonald, extending the

program's Lumsden Gymnasium winning streak to 44 straight games before it was snapped. The Wildcats have posted a 76-14 record in home games under MacDonald's guidance. They've set a new program benchmark for home wins in a season, posting identical 15-1 home records during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.

Before arriving at Daemen, MacDonald spent eight years (2006-14) leading the NCAA Division III program at Medaille where he transformed the Mavericks into a regional contender. Inheriting a program that went 4-46 in the two years prior to his arrival, MacDonald's version of the Mavericks averaged 18 wins per season, while advancing to the postseason six times.

Medaille's emergence as a Division III power in the Northeast was cemented in MacDonald's final five seasons there, as he led the Mavericks to more wins (101) than any other Division III team in New York State, while ranking 17th nationally in wins during the same time frame. MacDonald was named the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions (2006-07, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2011-12). He left as the school's all-time leader in wins (149) and winning percentage (.671).

Prior to his time at Medaille, MacDonald spent 18 years at Canisius, including a nine-year stint (1997-2006) as head coach. In that time, MacDonald guided the Golden Griffins to 108 wins which ranks him third in program history for coaching victories. While there, he was one of only five coaches in that program's storied history to orchestrate a 20-win season, and was named the 2000-01 BCANY Division I Co-Coach of the Year.

Before being elevated to the head coaching post at Canisius, MacDonald worked as an assistant on the Griffs' coaching staff, first under Marty Marbach and later under John Beilein. As Beilein's top assistant, MacDonald helped Canisius reach the 1996 NCAA tournament in addition to two National Invitational Tournament appearances.

In addition to his coaching accomplishments, MacDonald brings a strong connection to the local community. His teams have been active with a number of community organizations in the greater Buffalo community and beyond, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Buffalo, Blessed Sacrament Athletic Club and Coaches vs. Cancer. In August of 2020, MacDonald received the Jim Satalin Inspiration Award from the American Cancer Society of Western New York in recognition of his dedication and work on behalf of the Coaches vs. Cancer program.

MacDonald and several of his players have also worked with the Drug Enforcement Administration and Mayor Byron Brown's office on Game Changers, a nationally awarded program that provides academic and athletic opportunities for inner-city youths during the summer months.

A 1988 graduate of Saint Bonaventure University, MacDonald additionally serves Daemen as the [Senior Associate Athletics Director for External Relations](#). In that role, MacDonald has raised more than \$500,000 for the College. He resides in Amherst with his wife, Maura (nee Heary). The couple has raised four children - Matthew, Patrick, Nicholas and Mark. Matthew served as team captain during his collegiate career at the University of Pennsylvania and is now a player development assistant with the Brooklyn Nets. Patrick was a Division III All-American while playing at the State University of New York Maritime College, and is now enlisted in the United States Navy. Nicholas is a junior on the basketball team at Daemen, and Mark is a sophomore attending Canisius High School.

DEFENDING THE DEN

Success on their home floor has been a staple of Daemen's rise within the NCAA Division II ranks. The Wildcats have won 10+ home games in eight of the last 10 seasons, including identical 15-1 records during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 campaigns which established a new program benchmark for homecourt victories. Dating back to the 2017-18 season, Daemen has won 42 of their last 46 home games. Since joining the ECC (2013-14 season), Daemen is 59-10 in home conference games (.855 win %). The Wildcats are also 70-13 at home during the program's NCAA era (.843 win %). In the past 21 seasons, the Wildcats have won 83% of all home games, going 225-46.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Guards Sean Fasoyiro and Andrew Mason each made immediate contributions during their first season with the program in 2020-21. Fasoyiro was a first-team All-ECC and NABC All-District selection after finishing second on the team in scoring (13.9) and rebounding (7.1) while leading the squad in assists (3.9). Fasoyiro, a graduate transfer from Franklin Pierce, is competing in a fifth collegiate season and holds 97 games of playing experience under his belt. Mason burst on the scene as a freshman and started all 16 contests. He averaged 12.6 points and 6.1 rebounds per game while leading the ECC in three-point field goal accuracy (.487).

TEXAS-SIZED CHALLENGES

Daemen opened the season with three high-profile contests in Canyon, Texas as part of the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic held over Halloween weekend. The Wildcats knocked off Minnesota State Moorhead, 67-63, in the opener, thanks to the play of Nick MacDonald (17 points) and Andrew Sischo (16 points, 15 rebounds). The Dragons were ranked No. 25 in the D2SIDA preseason poll and picked to finish first in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. It marked the 18th time in the last 20 seasons that Daemen has started 1-0. A pair of losses to nationally ranked team followed. No. 4 Colorado Mesa got the best of the Wildcats, 76-65, using a 27-6 second-half spurt to erase a nine-point halftime deficit. Sischo was held to nine points, snapping a string of 67 consecutive double-figure games. The All-American big man was hampered by foul trouble and limited to 19 minutes - his lowest minute total since playing 10 against New York Tech on Dec. 16, 2018, a game he left due to an injury. Sischo returned to form in the tournament finale, finishing with 18 points and 15 boards, but it wasn't enough to lead Daemen past No. 3 West Texas A&M. In a rematch of last season's Elite Eight meeting. The Buffs came out on top again, this time by just three points (69-66). Sean Fasoyiro's tying three-point attempt fell short as the buzzer sounded. Both Sischo and Fasoyiro were named to the All-Tournament Team.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

The Daemen program has been built on sustained success, winning at least 19 games in nine of the last 10 seasons. That span encompasses the end of Daemen's NAIA Era, its' NCAA transition period and the first six seasons of full NCAA Division II membership. The Wildcats have won 72% of their contests, going 207-81 in that span. Looking more recently, Daemen is 80-28 in the last four seasons (.741 winning percentage).

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK

Daemen has earned three consecutive NCAA tournament berths. The Wildcats won 24 games (NCAA Era program record) and earned at-large bids to the NCAA tournament in 2019 and 2020. The Wildcats entered the 2021 tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Region and picked up their first-ever NCAA tourney win with an 81-69 defeat of third-seeded Bloomfield en route to the program's first regional championship and Elite Eight appearance.

DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Daemen's 2021-22 schedule will provide plenty of tests. The Wildcats are slated to play games against seven teams who were ranked in either the NABC or D2SIDA preseason national polls: Minnesota State Moorhead, Colorado Mesa, West Texas A&M, Mercyhurst, West Liberty, Saint Anselm, St. Thomas Aquinas. Daemen has recorded two wins over top-25 ranked teams in each of the last three seasons.

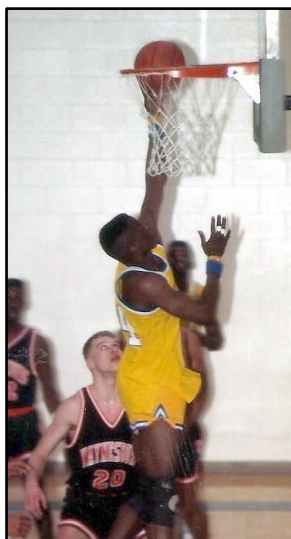

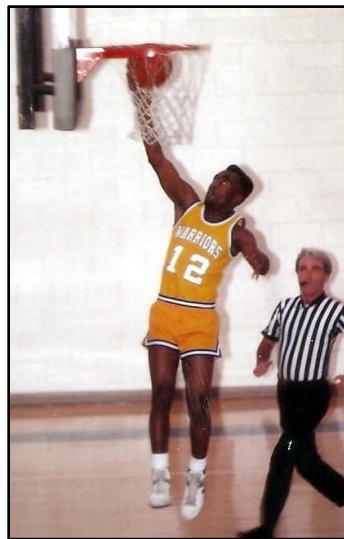

LAST GAME RECAP

Wildcats Drop Tournament Finale To Nationally-Ranked Buffs, 69-66

CANYON, Texas – The Daemen College men's basketball team battled No. 3 West Texas A&M University to the final buzzer tonight, but the host Buffs escaped with a 69-66 victory in the final game of the [Division II Conference Commissioner's Association \(D2CCA\) Tip-Off Classic](#). The three-day tournament took part at the First United Center on the campus of West Texas A&M.

The game was a rematch of last year's NCAA Division II Tournament Elite Eight matchup, which was won by West Texas A&M, 97-83. The host Buffs, who entered the tournament ranked No. 3 in the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) top 25 poll, improved to 3-0 on the year. Daemen is receiving votes in the NABA top 25.

Daemen, which dropped to 1-2, had a chance to send the game to overtime, but a last second three-point attempt by graduate student [Sean Fasoyiro](#) (Houston, Texas) was off the mark.

IMPACT PLAYERS

- Daemen's [Andrew Sischo](#) (Guilderland, N.Y.), who failed to score in double figures for the first time in 67-straight games last night during a loss to nationally-ranked Colorado Mesa University, was back in form tonight. The two-time consensus All-American totaled 18 points and 15 rebounds tonight and has now recorded a double-double in 19 of his last 22 games dating back to the 2019-20 season. Sischo, who has led NCAA Division II in double-doubles each of the last two seasons, has now totaled 62 career double-doubles in 107 career games.
- Fasoyiro added 15 points, five rebounds and two blocks. Both Sischo and Fasoyiro were named to the all-tournament team.
- Sophomore guard [Andrew Mason](#) (Webster, N.Y.) connected 4-of-6 three-point attempts and finished with 14 points, while redshirt junior [Ryan Bradley](#) (Niagara Falls, N.Y.) added eight points and five boards in just 11 minutes off the bench.
- Four players scored in double figures for the Buffs. Sophomore guard Larry Wise scored a team-high 15 points, while junior guard Julius Brown canned 3-of-6 from downtown and added 14 points and seven rebounds.

WILDCATS QUICKLY ERASE HALFTIME DEFICIT

West Texas held a 38-29 lead at the half, but the Wildcats outscored the Buffs 16-5 over the first 5:41 of the second half to erase the lead. Daemen opened the second half with a triple by Mason and later took a 45-43 lead after Mason and graduate student [Kyle Harris](#) (Buffalo, N.Y.) drilled back-to-back three-pointers. The remaining 14:19 of the game was back-and-forth, as neither team led by more than five points. Mason, who hit all four of his three-pointers in the second half, gave Daemen a 50-46 lead with a triple at the 12:52 mark, but the Wildcats went scoreless over the next three minutes and West Texas A&M took advantage with a 9-0 run that gave the hosts a 55-50 lead.

A jumper by Sischo with 6:32 left cut the West Texas A&M lead to two points, 59-57, but Wise was fouled attempting a three-pointer on the Buffs next possession and he canned all three free throws to put the lead back up to five points, 62-57. The Wildcats later pulled to within a point, 64-63, after Fasoyiro made two free throws with 3:49 left, and neither team scored again until Brown made one-of-two free throws with 2:17 to play.

Daemen came up empty on its next possession and Wise canned a jumper with 1:37 to play to give the hosts a 67-63 lead. Both teams failed to convert on their next possession, before Mason hit his fourth triple of the half with 22 seconds left to make it 67-66. West Texas got two free throws from Zach Toussaint with 19 seconds left, and Fasoyiro's last second attempt to tie the game was off the mark.

NEXT JUMP BALL

The Wildcats will play exhibition games against the University of Buffalo (Nov. 4) and Medaille College (Nov. 8), before they return to regular-season play the weekend of Nov. 12-13 when they host the [East Region Challenge presented by WNY Knee and Orthopedic Surgery PC](#).
