KNIGHT NOTES

OFF TO A GOOD START

Gannon started the 2020-21 season with back-to-back wins over Kentucky State at Hammermill Center. It marks the Knights' best start to a season since 2012-13 when Gannon started 5-0.

In the season opener against Kentucky State, the Knights rolled past the Thorobreds, 83-58. Gannon notched its largest margin of victory in a season-opening contest since it topped Urbana, 78-42, in the 2008-09 season.

With the win, the Knights improved to 56-20 all-time in season openers, including a 45-6 mark at home.

SHARING THE ROCK

As a team, Gannon is averaging 19.0 assists per contest. The Knights passed out a season-high 24 assists in game one against Kentucky State on Jan. 12. The performance marked the most assists in a game since the Knights handed out 27 against Clarion on Jan. 14, 2017.

In his Gannon debut, **Braden Olsen** waisted no time getting his teammates involved in the action passing out a game-high and career-best 12 assists.



He was the first Knight to reach double digits in assists in a game since Jimmy Berger notched 14 against California on Jan. 3, 2017. Olsen was also the first Gannon player to reach double figures in a season opener since Ron Hollis passed out 10 vs. CW Post on Nov. 24, 2006.

LOTS OF DEPTH

Gannon leaned on its depth in its twogame series against Kentucky State on Jan. 12 and Jan. 13. Of the 15 total players on the roster, 13 players saw playing time in the series. In both games, 10 different players contributed at least one point.

PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF

Chris Clancy picked up where he left off starting both games against Kentucky State and is averaging a team-high 15.0 points per contest. He reached double digits in scoring in both contests after netting 15 points each night.

On the defensive end of the floor, Clancy created five total steals, including a career-best four steals against Kentucky State on Jan. 12.

GETTING THE JOB DONE

Kevin Dodds is averaging 9.0 points and team-best 8.5 rebounds per game. In game two against Kentucky State on Jan. 13, Dodds logged his first double-double of the season and second of his career after hauling a game-high and careerbest 13 rebounds with 12 points.

GANNON AT A GLANCE

Gannon enters the 2020-21 season returning seven players from last season, including five starters. The Golden Knights bring back five players that have played in at least 20 career games.

Michael Tertsea and Sean Colosimo are the only seniors on the roster. Tertsea appeared in 25 games (20 starts) and posted a team-high 19 blocks last season, while Colosimo has seen action in 27 career games with three starts.

LOOKING BACK AT LAST SEASON

Gannon finished the 2019-20 season with a 14-13 overall record and made its ninth appearance in the PSAC Tournament in program history in head coach **Kelvin Jefferson's** first season.

The Golden Knights ranked inside the top five in four categories in the PSAC: rebounding margin (2nd, +5.3), free throw shooting percentage (3rd, .760), steals per game (3rd, 7.70) and defense (4th, 67.9).

VETERAN PRESENCE

Gannon has seven players on the roster that enter the season having played in at least 20 career games. Cyril Ogbuagu and Kevin Dodds pace the Knights returning to the roster having appeared in 43 career games over three seasons.

Braden Olsen, who enters his first season at Gannon after transferring from Seattle Pacific, appeared in 52 games over three seasons with the Falcons.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Michael Tertsea, Sean Colosimo and **Chris Clancy** have been named team captains for the 2020-21 season.

"Chris, Sean and Mike bring a combination of experience and maturity that all captains need," said head coach **Kelvin Jefferson**. "They are three of the hardest workers on the team and will always put the team first. I am excited to work with these three as we embark on what is sure to be an exciting chapter in Gannon basketball."

IN THE CLASSROOM

For the 12th time in its 12 years as a member of the PSAC, Gannon produced the highest percentage of student-athletes named PSAC Scholar-Athletes in 2019-20.

Gannon set a new mark for the third year in a row with 324 of 519 eligible student-athletes being named Scholar-Athletes, giving Gannon the third-highest percentage of student-athletes on the list with 62 percent. A student-athlete must maintain a 3.25 GPA or better to earn the recognition.

In **Kelvin Jefferson's** first season, men's basketball had five players earn honors: Chris Clancy, Sean Colosimo, Jonathan Harewood, Ryan Rachic and Javier Valeiras.

FROM RIVALS TO TEAMMATES

Ike Herster and Alfonso Pickens Jr. are familiar with the local basketball scene in Erie, Pa. Herster grew up in Sharon, Pa., and attended Kennedy Catholic, while Pickens is a native of Erie, Pa. and attended Cathedral Prep.



The duo squared off numerous times in their high school careers and were both named to the Erie Times-News All-District 10 big-school team in 2019.

GANNON FAMILY

Ian McNeill is no stranger to the tradition of Gannon basketball. He is the son of former Golden Knight basketball player James McNeill (1980-81).

He is also the brother-in-law of former Gannon basketball player **Matt Jones** (2001-05). Jones holds the record for most consecutive free throws made (37), ranks 14th on the Gannon all-time games played list (106), positioned eighth on the all-time free throw percentage list (.831) and was named to the All-GLIAC Second Team in 2005.

PRO KNIGHTS

Former guard Raphell Thomas-Edwards (2013-15) signed a one-year extension with the Bristol Flyers in the British Basketball Leagué (BBL) on July 28, 2020.

Former guard **Jabs Newby** (2012-14) signed with the Fraser Valley Bandits in the Canadian Elite Basketball League (CEBL) on April 9, 2020.

In total, Gannon has had 24 players in advance to play basketball at the professional level.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Daemen enters the 2020-21 season after posting a 24-8 overall record last season and made an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Wildcats are members of the East Coast Conference.

Daemen is positioned tied for No. 25 in the D2SIDA National Media Poll and receiving votes in the NABC Top 25 Poll.

Daemen was scheduled to play Mercyhurst on Jan. 16 before the contest was postponed due to COVID-19 protocol.

Daemen is led by head coach **Mike MacDonald**, who is entering his seventh season. He has a compiled a 129-51 over six seasons.

The Wildcats are led by redshirt senior **Andrew Sischo** after averaging 24.9 points and 11.7 rebounds last season. Sisch set the East Coast Conference record for total points (773) and field goals (298). He also led the nation in total rebounds (362) and double-doubles (22).

Gannon has called Hammermill Center home since the 1949-50 season. The facility was orginally known as the Gannon Auditorium before it was rededicated in February of 1983 in honor of the Hammermill Papermill Company, whose generosity enabled the university to make necessary repairs and improvements.

Hammermill Center has a capacity of 2,800 and has often been referred to as one of the toughest places to play in Division II by visiting coaches. Over 71 seasons in Hammermill Center, Gannon holds an 871-260 (.768) overall record. The Knights posted a 7-6 record at home last season and ranked second in the PSAC in attendence.

- Kelvin Jefferson was named head coach at Gannon on April 30, 2019.
- Jefferson is the 19th head coach in program history and enters his second season in 2020-21.
- Jefferson brings 25 years of coaching experience with him to Erie, including 12 seasons as a Division I assistant and eight as head coach of the elite prep team at South Kent School in Connecticut.
- In his first season, Jefferson guided the Golden Knights to a fifth place finish in the PSAC West with a 14-13 overall record and 13-9 in the PSAC.
- Gannon capped the season making its ninth appearance in the PSAC Tournament in 2019-20.
- The Knights leaned on their defense that finished fourth in the PSAC and held their opponents to 60 points or less in eight games. Gannon proved to be one of the best rebounding teams in the PSAC finishing the season second in rebounding margin. The Knights also ranked third in both free throw percentage and steals in the PSAC in 2019-20.
- Jefferson helped produce two All-PSAC selections in 2019-20. DeAnte Cisero and Frank Webb Jr. were both named to the All-PSAC Second Team for the first time in their careers.
- Before coming to Gannon, Jefferson spent the three seasons as an assistant at Division I Old Dominion, where he helped the Monarchs go 70-28 over three seasons, capping the run with the 2018-19 Conference USA regular season and tournament title and the program's first NCAA tournament berth since 2011.
- ODU earned five all-conference honors during his stay in Norfolk, Virginia, including three first-teamers and the 2018-19 Conference USA Player of the Year in B.J. Stith, who also earned Associated Press honorable mention All-American laurels.
- A native of Norwalk, Connecticut, Jefferson received his bachelor's degree in journalism from Southern Connecticut State in 1995. He played three seasons as a forward for the Division II Owls, averaging 7.1 points and 6.1 rebounds in 75 career games. He began his college career with one season at Clark University in Massachusetts.
- Jefferson was a captain of the SCSU team during his senior season, and off the court, he was a sports writer for the student newspaper, as well as a member of the Black Student Union and Student Advisory Committee.

DEVELOPED UNDER JEFFERSON

Jefferson spent nine seasons as the head coach of South Kent Prep from 2008-16 posting a 131-76 overall record, where he helped develop six future NBA players, including 2012 Big East Rookie of the Year Moe Harkless of St. John's, Louisville All-American and national champion Russ Smith, and All-American and 2014 Big Ten Player of the Year Nik Stauskas of Michigan.











In total, over 50 players who played under Jefferson at South Kent signed with a Division I program. He also helped Matt Moyer, who currently plays for Vanderbilt, and current Boston Celtic Tremont Waters earn Connecticut Gatorade Player of the Year honors.
