

JUMP BALL

Daemen officially opens the 2021-22 season this weekend with two games at the Redhawks Classic hosted by Roberts Wesleyan. It marks the sixth time in the last seven seasons that the Wildcats have started at a RWC-hosted tournament. Daemen will face one of the East Region's premier teams Friday night as they battle St. Anselm. They'll close the tournament Saturday afternoon by facing Felician.

A MAGICAL RUN

The Wildcats earned their second consecutive NCAA tournament berth and captured their first regional title last March. After entering the tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional, the Wildcats ran to a 73-54 win over third-seeded Georgian Court in the regional semifinals, marking the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. The Wildcats followed up with a 58-40 defeat of fifth-seeded Roberts Wesleyan in the regional final, avenging a loss just nine days prior in the ECC Championship final. Katie Titus was named the Most Outstanding Player of the East Regional after netting 22 points to go with seven rebounds, three blocks and two steals in the regional final. The postseason run came to an end just over a week later in Columbus, Ohio where the Wildcats suffered a 66-49 loss in the Elite Eight to top-seeded and eventual national champion Lubbock Christian.

RELOADED

Daemen is set to return 13 players, including four starters, from their regional championship team players responsible for 78% of scoring, 81% of rebounds and 85% of their assists from a season ago. Among the returners is senior forward Katie Titus who was recently named the ECC Preseason Player of the Year. A 6-foot forward, Titus produced a career-high 14.8 points per game last season. She led the ECC in three-point field goals (48) and blocks (40) while also ranking second in rebounding (8.1 rpg) and third in scoring en route to earning honorable mention All-American honors. Redshirt senior guard Tiara Filbert - the 2020-21 ECC Preseason Player of the Year - is also set to return after being limited to just eight games by an injury last season. A three-time All-ECC selection, Filbert enters her final collegiate season with 1,096 points in 93 games played. Senior forward Mickayla Ivy (9.4 ppg, 6.5 rpg) and sophomore guard Alahna Paige (2020-21 ECC Rookie of the Year) also return.

BANK ON IT

Jenepher Banker returns for her sixth season on the Daemen bench and her 11th overall as a collegiate head coach. The veteran mentor has led Daemen to a 78-50 record since taking the reins in 2016, with 55 of her victories coming over the past three seasons. The Wildcats' success under Banker includes a 23-win season in 2019-20 (a benchmark for wins during the program's NCAA Division II era), back-to-back regular season conference titles, the program's first ECC tournament championship, a pair of NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 regional title. She was named the ECC Coach of the Year after leading the Wildcats to an unbeaten run through conference play. Including her five seasons as the head coach at Penn State Behrend, Banker enters the season just five wins shy of 150 for her career.

IN THE POLLS

For the first time in the program's NCAA Division II era (2015-present), the Wildcats are nationally ranked to start the season. Daemen is ranked 20th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Preseason Top 25 Coaches Poll and eighth in the Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA) Preseason Media Poll. The Wildcats ended the 2020-21 season ranked eighth in both polls - the first time they've finished a season in the national rankings.

MILESTONE CHASE

Senior forward Katie Titus will open the season needing just 42 points to become the 27th member of Daemen's 1,000-point club. In 73 career games, Titus has made 65 starts and totaled 958 points, 573 rebounds and 127 blocked shots. A three-time All-ECC selection, Titus is also bidding to become just the fourth player in program history to have 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks in a career.

HIGH ECC-XPECTATIONS

For the second straight season, Daemen has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the ECC. The Wildcats were the near unanimous choice atop the ECC Preseason Coaches' Poll, garnering nine of the 10 first-place votes and 97 points. The Wildcats posted a 9-0 ECC record last season - the program's first unbeaten conference season since 2003-04 - and hold a 37-6 conference mark over the past three seasons.

TUNING UP

Daemen got a dress rehearsal opportunity last week as they met Division I Buffalo in an exhibition contest at Alumni Arena. The highly touted Bulls, who are picked to win the MAC tournament this season, scored a 98-43 win in the teams' third exhibition matchup since 2010. Kaytlyn Matz (11 points) and Mickayla Ivy (10 points, five rebounds) led the Wildcats.

ST. ANSELM SCOUTING REPORT

The St. Anselm Hawks are members of the Northeast-10 Conference and are led by veteran head coach Corey Boillard who returns for his fifth season with the program and his 10th as a collegiate head coach overall. Boillard has led the Hawks to a 60-29 overall record, two NCAA tournament berths and the 2019 East Region championship. Just six players remain from the Hawks' 2019-20 team that finished 21-7 overall. The Hawks did not compete during the 2020-21 season due to Covid-19.

Headlining the St. Anselm returners is senior guard Peyton Steinman who earned First Team All-NE-10 honors in 2019-20. A 5-foot-8 guard, Steinman finished second in the league in scoring (19.6 ppg) and tallied a team-high 102 assists. She has scored 10+ points in 33 straight games.

Junior guard Macy Spinks also returns after being named to the NE-10 All-Rookie Team in 2019-20. Spinks started 27 of 28 contests that season and averaged 6.2 points and 3.1 assists per game.

The Hawks were picked third in the NE-10 Northeast Division preseason poll, behind only Stonehill and Bentley. The Hawks are seeking their first NE-10 championship since the 1990-91 season. Friday's game vs. Daemen is their first in 614 days.

Did you know that St. Anselm is one of three Northeast-10 Conference opponents on Daemen's 2021-22 schedule? In addition to the Hawks, Daemen will play Stonehill and Bentley. Each of the opponents were picked in the top three of the NE-10 Northeast Division preseason coaches' poll.

FELICIAN SCOUTING REPORT

The Felician Falcons are members of the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference and are led by veteran head coach Steve Fagan. Now in his 14th season with the program, Fagan has led the Falcons to 113 wins and six CACC tournament berths. Eight players, including three who started at least seven games, return from Felician's 2020-21 team that finished 0-11.

Junior guard/forward Briana Lee leads the Felician returners after averaging a team-high 18.0 points and 12.1 rebounds per game last season. She ranked first in rebounding and second in scoring among the CACC leaders. The New Jersey native has averaged 16.3 points and 9.5 rebounds in 32 career games.

Junior forward Tiara Mahorn (7.1 ppg) and senior guard Niaimani Marshall (6.8 ppg) also return. Newcomer Katelyn Andres will look to make an immediate impact as she returns to her home state as a grad student after beginning her career at Post.

The Falcons were picked sixth in the CACC North Division preseason poll.

JENEPHER BANKER HEAD COACH • SIXTH SEASON • SPRINGFIELD, '85

Jenepher Banker will embark on her sixth season as the head women's basketball coach at Daemen College in 2021-22 as she continues to build Western New York's premier NCAA Division II program. Banker was <u>introduced in 2016 as the fourth head coach</u> in the modern era of the program and has since led the Wildcats to a 78-50 overall record and a 54-25 mark in East Coast Conference play.

The veteran mentor has presided over the program's resurgence in recent years, leading the Wildcats to back-to-back ECC regular season championships, an ECC tournament title and two NCAA tournament berths. From early January of 2019 through the end of the 2020-21 season, Banker's Wildcats went 51-10.

The 2020-21 season was a historic one as Banker guided the Wildcats to the NCAA Division II East Region championship, advancing to the Elite Eight for the first time in the program's NCAA era. It was a remarkable run, especially considering the circumstances. The start of the season was delayed until mid-January due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but once it got underway, the Wildcats were off and running. They rattled off 12 wins in their first 13 contests with the only setback coming against nationally ranked Gannon. The success included a 9-0 run through ECC play as the Wildcats completed an unbeaten conference slate for just the third time in program history.

After stumbling in the final round of the ECC Championship, Banker refocused the group heading into NCAA tournament play. With the East Regional held on their home floor at Lumsden Gymnasium, the second-seeded Wildcats ousted third-seeded Georgian Court 73-54 to secure the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. Banker and the squad would go on to cut down the nets following a 58-40 win over fifth-seeded and long-time rival Roberts Wesleyan in the regional final, avenging their conference tournament loss to the Redhawks and snapping their region-best nine-game winning streak in the process.

Daemen's historic run came to an end at the Greater Columbus (Ohio) Convention Center where, as the No. 8 seed, they fell 66-49 to top-seeded and eventual national champion Lubbock Christian. The Wildcats ended the year ranked eighth in national polls conducted by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA). They were driven all season by their defense, finishing third in the country in both scoring defense (51.6 ppg) and field goal percentage defense (.325).

Banker guided the squad to a 23-5 overall record - the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13 - as well as a share of the ECC regular season championship and the ECC tournament title during the 2019-20 campaign. They did so by combining stingy defense with solid offensive production, especially from behind the three-point arc. The Wildcats allowed just 55.0 points per game, ranking 13th in the country, and went 9-1 when holding opponents to less than 50 points. On the offensive end, Daemen set program records for three-pointers made in a game (20 vs. Queens on January 10) and season (238) and ranked first in the ECC for three-pointers made per game (8.5). Daemen's +14.1 scoring margin also topped the ECC and ranked 30th nationally.

The team's success in 2019-20 included a 13-game winning streak spanning some 69 days - the longest winning streak of the program's NCAA Division II era. The Wildcats also posted a 9-0 record at home, going undefeated for the third time in program history and for the first time since 2007-08.

After going 13-3 during the conference regular season, the Wildcats experienced postseason success with two wins at the ECC tournament which was played at the UDC Sports Complex in Washington, D.C. Second-seeded Daemen knocked off third-seeded New York Tech in the semifinals, 76-56, on March 7. A day later, Banker led the Wildcats

to a 68-56 win over fourth-seeded Molloy in the finals, riding the double-double performance (24 points, 13 rebounds) of sophomore forward Katie Titus who was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

The conference tournament title came with an automatic bid to the 2020 NCAA tournament. Daemen was awarded the No. 7 seed in the East Region, and was set to make its NCAA tournament debut against second-seeded Stonehill. However, the tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The groundwork for championship seasons was laid in the years prior. Inheriting a team that won nine games in the season before her arrival, Banker led the team to 11 wins in her debut season and 12 more during the 2017-18 campaign which included the program's first ECC tournament berth.

In 2018-19, Banker led the Wildcats to an 18-10 overall record and a 15-3 mark in conference games. The 15 conference wins established a new benchmark for Daemen's ECC era as the Wildcats placed second in the ECC standings. The Wildcats also achieved their first-ever regional ranking at the Division II level that season, debuting in the D2SIDA East Region media poll in a tie for No. 10 on February 4. They later debuted at No. 10 in the official NCAA regional poll released on February 20. Daemen's ascent into the regional conversation came in the midst of winning 14 of their final 15 regular season contests, including a streak of 11 in a row. Banker picked up her 100th win as a collegiate head coach along the way, a 79-47 defeat of conference foe District of Columbia on

on January 27.

Over her first five seasons at the helm, Banker has played an integral role in the development of eight all-conference players. Those players account for 14 total all-conference selections, including firstteam picks Sarah Saba (2017, 2018), Katie Titus (2019, 2021), Tiara Filbert (2020, 2021) and Caroline White (2020, 2021). Additionally, Titus (2019 ECC Rookie of the Year), White (2021 ECC Player of the Year) and Alahna Paige (2021 ECC Rookie of the Year) have garnered major ECC awards during Banker's tenure. Also in 2021, Banker was named the ECC Coach of the Year while White and Titus picked up honorable mention All-American honors from he WBCA.

Banker holds more than 30 years of coaching experience at various levels, ranging from Division I to high school. Her first collegiate experience came as an assistant coach at Iowa State University, then of the Big Eight Conference, from 1986-88, and later as an assistant at Canisius College from 1993-95.

Between assistant coaching stops, Banker served as the head coach at Penn State-Behrend in Erie, Pa. While there, she led the Lions' NCAA Division III program to a 67-61 overall record, including a 41-12 mark in her final two seasons. Her 1991-92 team went 23-4, winning the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) South Region championship. That season, her team garnered Penn State-Behrend's first-ever national ranking in any sport. She still ranks second all-time in coaching victories, and was inducted into Penn State-Behrend's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1994.

Later, Banker settled at the high school level, coaching the varsity team at Grand Island High School from 1998-2013, building the Lady Vikings into a regional contender with seven Section VI championships, four appearances in the Far West Regional, and one appearance at the New York State final four. During her tenure, Banker's teams were recognized with the New York State Scholar-Athlete Team Award for 15 straight seasons, and she developed 10 players that went on to play college basketball, as well as four of the five 1,000-point scorers in school history.

In addition, Banker has also coached twice in the Empire State Games, formerly a set of annual Olympic-style competitions for amateur athletes from the state of New York.

Banker, who played collegiately and was an Academic All-American and 1,000-point scorer at Springfield College (Mass.), graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1985 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education. She would later add a Master of Science Degree in Athletic Administration from Iowa State in 1988. After serving as a physical education instructor at Iowa State, Penn State-Behrend and Canisius, she had, since 1998, been a physical education teacher in the Grand Island School District where she has also served as the Director of Community Education.

She resides in Grand Island with her husband, Brett. Together, the couple has raised two children. Their son, Kolby, is the head women's soccer coach at Erie Community College. Their daughter, Kallie, is a former Division I basketball player at both the University of Rhode Island and the University of Vermont, who now serves as Daemen's top assistant.

SWEET CAROLINE

The biggest missing piece from last season is forward Caroline White who was lost to graduation last spring. White earned ECC Player of the Year honors last season after averaging 15.2 points (second in ECC) and 8.5 rebounds (first in ECC) per game.

T IT UP

Daemen will regain the services of redshirt senior guard Tiara Filbert to start the 2021-22 season. A three-time All-ECC selection, Filbert missed the final nine games last season with an injury. She has appeared in 93 games in her career, averaging 11.8 points, 4.6 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game. In Daemen's 2020-21 season opener, she became the 25th member of the program's 1,000 Point Club. Filbert currently ranks 20th in program history with 1,096 career points.

BREAKOUT SEASON

Senior forward Mickayla Ivy will look to take her game to another level after experiencing a breakout campaign in 2020-21. After averaging 2.8 points and 2.6 rebounds per game in her first two seasons, Ivy emerged as a consistent performer at both ends of the floor last season. She started all 17 contests and averaged 9.4 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 50% from the field. Her contributions were recognized by the ECC coaches who voted her onto the All-ECC Second Team.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Daemen has held 38 of its last 45 opponents to 65 points or less, posting a 35-3 record in those games. The Wildcats were among the best defensive teams in the country in 2020-21, ranking third nationally in both field goal percentage defense (.325) and scoring defense (51.6).

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Daemen has posted a 51-10 record in their last 61 games, a span that dates back to mid-January of 2019. The Wildcats have won 10 of their 13 regular season, non-conference games in that time.

SEASON OPENERS

Daemen has posted a 7-3 record in season-opening tournaments hosted by

Roberts Wesleyan since the start of the 2015-16 season. The Wildcats have started 1-0 in three of the last five seasons, including their 82-64 defeat of Mercyhurst to start the 2020-21 campaign.

FRESH FACES

Daemen welcomes just two newcomers to the roster this season. Junior guard Sarah Cloutier is a transfer from NAIA affiliate Southeastern where she appeared in 38 games over two seasons while helping the Fire post a 53-6 record. Guard Sydney Hvizdzak is the lone freshmen on Daemen's roster. She comes to the Wildcats after earning All-Western New York honors last winter when she averaged 26.9 points and 9.6 rebounds per game while leading Randolph to the Section VI Class C title game. Hvizdzak is one of only 15 women in Section VI history to surpass 2,000 career points.

LAST TIME OUT

BUFFALO, N.Y. - In their first and only dress rehearsal for the 2021-22 season, the Daemen women's basketball team dropped a 98-43 decision to host Buffalo in an exhibition game at Alumni Arena.

Led by Preseason All-Mid American Conference guard Dyaisha Fair, the Division I Bulls led from start to finish against their Division II counterparts. UB forced 10 first quarter turnovers and took a 50-16 lead into halftime. The Bulls are coming off a 15-9 campaign and were picked third in the MAC Preseason Coaches' Poll.

Daemen, which enters the season ranked in both Division II national polls (No. 20 WBCA; No. 8 D2SIDA), started slowly, but settled down with three-pointers from <u>Kaytlyn Matz</u> (Johnsburg, III.) and <u>Katie Titus</u> (Penfield, N.Y.) and a mid-range jumper from <u>Mickayla Ivy</u> (Grand Rapids, Mich.) in the first quarter. But, coming out of the first media timeout, UB embarked on an 11-0 spurt to firmly grasp control.

The Bulls kept the momentum going and outscored the Wildcats 27-8 in the second quarter. The Wildcats gained better footing in the second half, scoring 27 points on 11-of-31 shooting.

IMPACT PLAYERS

- Fair, who led the Bulls in scoring, rebounding and assists last season, stuffed the stat sheet tonight, finishing with 20 points, eight assists and five rebounds. She connected on 4-of-10 three-pointers in the game.
- Redshirt senior forward Summer Hemphill shot 8-for-11 from the field and finished with 17 points to go with a teamhigh eight rebounds.
- Freshman guard Georgia Woolley (14 points) and senior forward Adebola Adeyeye (10 points) also reached double figures for the Bulls. Woolley came off the bench to drill 4-of-6 from three-point range.
- Matz led the Wildcats with 11 points, including a trio of three-pointers, while Ivy finished with 10 points, five boards, a block and a steal.
- Titus, the East Coast Conference Preseason Player of the Year, scored eight points, grabbed six rebounds and dished three assists.
- Redshirt senior guard <u>Tiara Filbert</u> (Batavia, N.Y.) made her return to the lineup and scored three points while grabbing six boards. Filbert, a three-time All-ECC selection, missed the final nine games last season with an injury.

GAME NOTES

- Daemen returns 13 players, including four starters, from their 2020-21 team that finished with a 14-3 record after winning the program's first East Region championship and advancing to the Elite Eight round of the NCAA Division II tournament. The Wildcats have been picked first in the East Coast Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- UB returns nine scholarship players who accounted for 76% of scoring, 71% of rebounding and 66% of minutes played last season.
- Tonight's game marked the third exhibition meeting between Daemen and UB since 2010, and the first since 2015. UB has won all three meetings. It was also the Wildcats' first exhibition game against a Division I opponent since an 80-73 loss to Canisius in head coach *Jenepher Banker*'s Daemen coaching debut on Nov. 9, 2016.
- Buffalo (58) and Daemen (55) have the most wins among Western New York's NCAA women's basketball programs since the start of the 2018-19 season.

The Wildcats tip it up for real on Friday, November 12 (6 p.m.) when they face regional foe St. Anselm in the opening round of the Redhawks Classic hosted by Roberts Wesleyan.
