JUMP BALL

Daemen makes its long-awaited home debut Saturday when they host a non-conference game against unbeaten Saint Rose. The Wildcats are coming off an 80-61 win over Staten Island in their East Coast Conference season opener earlier this week. The win snapped a three-game slide and helped the Wildcats avoid their first four-game losing streak since the 2010-11 season. Andrew Sischo netted 24 points and grabbed 11 rebounds while frontcourt mate Ryan Bradley had career-highs in points (15), rebounds (9), field goals (7), blocks (2) and steals (2).

RELOADED

Daemen returns 11 players, including all five starters, from their regional championship team players responsible for 98% of scoring, 99% of rebounding and assists from a season ago. None is bigger, both literally and figuratively, than center Andrew Sischo who returns for a fifth collegiate season after averaging 26.9 points and 13.0 rebounds per game last season. Fellow All-ECC picks Sean Fasoyiro (13.9 ppg, 7.1 rpg, 3.9 apg) and Kyle Harris (12.5 ppg, 39% 3PT) also return, along with Ryan Salzberg (8.6 ppg, 36% 3PT) and Andrew Mason (12.6 ppg, 6.1 rpg, 49% 3PT).

A MAGICAL RUN

The Wildcats earned their third consecutive NCAA tournament berth and captured their first regional title last March. After entering the tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional, the Wildcats ran to an 81-69 win over third-seeded Bloomfield in the regional semifinals, marking the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. The Wildcats followed up with a 71-70 defeat of top-seeded St. Thomas Aguinas in the regional final, avenging a loss just nine days prior in the ECC Championship final. Andrew Sischo was named the Most Outstanding Player of the East Regional after netting 25 points and grabbing 13 rebounds in the final. The Wildcats' run came to an end just over a week later in Evansville, Indiana where they suffered a 97-83 loss in the Elite Eight to top-seeded and eventual national runner-up West Texas A&M. The Wildcats finished with a 10-6 overall record and were ranked ninth in the final D2SIDA national media poll.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

Graduate student Andrew Sischo is arguably the most decorated Daemen student-athlete of all-time. He entered his final collegiate season as the active scoring (2,223) and rebounding (1,101) leader among all NCAA Division II players. A two-time consensus All-American, Sischo is coming off his finest season to date as he averaged careerhighs in scoring (26.9 ppg - a Daemen single

season record) and rebounding (13.0 rpg). Sischo scored 20+ points in 14 of 15 games last season and, including this year, has scored 10+ points in 70 of his last 71 games. He has 64 double-doubles in 109 career games and has led Division II in double-doubles in each of the last two seasons. Sischo was named the East Conference Preseason Player of the Year for an unprecedented fourth time.

MILESTONE MOMENTS

Andrew Sischo recently surpassed a pair of milestones, adding to his collection of career achievements. In Daemen's season opener vs. Minnesota State Moorhead, Sischo became Daemen's all-time leading rebounder, supplanting Alex Nwora who had 1,103 rebounds in his career from 1989-93. The following night against Colorado Mesa, Sischo became the all-time leading scorer in East Coast Conference history, breaking the benchmark of 2,247 points set by former St. Thomas Aquinas star Justin Reyes from 2014-18. Sischo became Daemen's all-time scoring leader last season and is the first player in program history to reach 2,000 points. He is only the second player in ECC history (Reyes) with 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds, and he already holds Daemen and ECC records for career field goals (922). He passed Reyes for second on the ECC's all-time rebounding list during a 13-rebound outing vs. Mercyhurst. He needs 119 rebounds to become the ECC's all-time leader.

RETURN OF THE MAC

Mike MacDonald returns for his eighth season on Daemen's bench and his 25th overall as a collegiate head coach. The veteran mentor has led Daemen to a 141-60 record since taking the reins in 2014. The Wildcats rank second in victories among all East Coast Conference and New York State Division II teams in that span. MacDonald is among an elite fraternity of coaches to have achieved 100 victories across all three NCAA divisions, and he entered the season just four wins shy of 400 for his career.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

Daemen's most high-profile roster addition came in the form of 6-foot-5 guard Nick MacDonald, the son of head coach Mike MacDonald, who elected to transfer after two seasons at Division I Niagara. The younger MacDonald provides another three-point shooting option to an already potent team. The Wildcats ranked second in the ECC and 32nd nationally last season by averaging 9.6 made three-pointers per game. MacDonald shot 35% from deep and connected on 50 three-pointers in his two seasons with the Purple Eagles.

SAINT ROSE SCOUTING REPORT

Saint Rose is a member of the Northeast-10 Conference and head coach Mike Perno is in his fourth season at the helm. The Golden Knights return 10 players from their 2020-21 team that posted a 4-3 record during a season that was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Golden Knights were one of only three NE-10 teams that competed at all during the 2020-21 season.

Coach Perno has Saint Rose off to a 4-0 start for the first time since the 2016-17 season. After picking up lopsided wins over transitioning programs D'Youville (101-65) and Staten Island (112-54) on opening weekend, the Golden Knights have added a pair of conference wins. They knocked off Adelphi on the road, 82-81, and earlier this week outlasted Le Moyne, 88-84, in their home debut.

The fast start has Saint Rose ranked 10th in the D2SIDA East Region media poll while also receiving votes in the National Association of Basketball Coaches Division II top-25 poll.

Freshman guard/forward Shane O'Dell has powered the Saint Rose offense thus far by averaging 22.3 points per game. O'Dell has gone for 20+ points in three straight games, including a career-high 28 in the recent win over Le Moyne.

The Golden Knights are getting additional offensive production from sophomore forward Eric Fleming (16.0 ppg), freshman guard Tray Alexander (12.0 ppg) and sophomore guard/forward Cartier Bowman (11.0 ppg). In all, Saint Rose boasts seven players averaging at least 8.0 points per game.

One face that will be familiar to Wildcat fans is that of fifth-year senior Kevin Lynch, a 6-foot-6 forward who transferred to Saint Rose after playing four years at St. Thomas Aquinas. Lynch has started the last two games and is averaging 6.5 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.



MIKE MACDONALD HEAD COACH • EIGHTH SEASON • ST. BONAVENTURE, '88

A fixture in the college basketball coaching fraternity, Mike MacDonald has been roaming sidelines, mentoring players and giving the occasional earful to referees for the last 33 years, all within Western New York. With previous stops at Canisius College and Medaille College, MacDonald has worked across all three NCAA divisions, racking up nearly 400 victories in 24 seasons as a head coach. His coaching success aside, MacDonald's personable nature and his willingness to give back to the local community have made him one of the most highly thought of people in the WNY sports community.

The 2021-22 season marks MacDonald's eighth at Daemen. Since being introduced as the sixth head coach in the modern history of the program, MacDonald has guided the Wildcats to a 139-57 overall record, an East Coast Conference (ECC) regular season championship, three NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 NCAA Division II East Region championship. Daemen ranks second for total wins among New York State's Division II programs since MacDonald came to Main Street.

The veteran bench boss has presided over Daemen's emergence as a power within the NCAA Division II East Region, a period that's been one of the most successful in program history. The team's 89 wins from the start of the 2016-17 season through the 2019-20 campaign is tied for the most in any four-year stretch dating back to the 1986-87 season. More than half of those wins came during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons as MacDonald led Daemen to back-to-back 24-win campaigns, setting the benchmark for victories during the program's NCAA Division II era. Since the start of the 2018-19 season, the Wildcats have spent a combined 33 weeks ranked in top-25 national polls conducted by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA), rising as high as No. 8 in both.

The positive momentum has led to numerous opportunities not otherwise afforded to teams from similar institutions, with MacDonald playing a central role. In recent years, MacDonald has taken teams to play exhibition contests against Division I opponents such as Buffalo, Siena and Syracuse. The Wildcats were invited participants at the prestigious Small College Basketball National Hall of Fame Classic to start the 2019-20 season. Daemen also played their first-ever game at Downtown Buffalo's KeyBank Center on November 23, 2019, defeating Wilmington (Del.) in a thriller, 83-81. It was MacDonald's 18th win in the building - the most of any basketball coach in the venue's history.

After leading Daemen to the ECC regular season title with a 16-2 mark in conference play in 2018-19, MacDonald steered the team into the NCAA tournament for the first time as the Wildcats were awarded an at-large bid as the No. 5 seed in the East Region. Daemen made their NCAA tournament debut on March 16, 2019, falling to fourth-seeded New Haven in an opening round contest played in Manchester, N H

Buoyed by All-American Andrew Sischo, the Wildcats were set to return to the NCAA tournament in 2020, again garnering at-large consideration, this time as the No. 8 seed in the East Region. However, the COVID-19 pandemic caused the unprecedented cancellation of NCAA championships before the tournament got underway.

As the pandemic continued to wreak havoc on the world of intercollegiate athletics in 2020-21, MacDonald prepped his team for a return to competition. It ended up being a historic season for the Wildcats who finished 10-6 overall and ranked No. 9 in the final D2SIDA national poll. It marked the first time in Daemen's NCAA era that the program had finished a season ranked among the top 25 teams in the country. After opening the season with back-to-back losses, MacDonald guided the group to wins in seven of their final nine regular season contests, and ultimately advanced to the final round of the ECC Championship for the first time since 2016. After falling to rival St. Thomas Aquinas in the conference tournament final, the Wildcats were awarded a third consecutive at-large bid to the NCAA tournament, entering as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional. MacDonald led the Wildcats to their first-ever NCAA tournament win, an 81-69 dispatching of third-seeded Bloomfield on March 14. Two nights later they avenged their earlier loss to St. Thomas Aquinas, winning 71-70 against the region's No. 1 seed to claim the East Region title. Daemen advanced to the Elite Eight where they fell against top-seeded West Texas A&M at the Ford Center in Evansville, Ind.

Milestones and accolades have poured in throughout MacDonald's tenure with the Wildcats. His 350th career win came in dramatic fashion on January 18, 2019 as junior guard Breon Harris scored five points in the final 21 seconds to lift the Wildcats past Mercy, 75-74. His 100th win at Daemen came just three weeks later, placing MacDonald among an elite fraternity of coaches who have achieved at least 100 wins while coaching in each of the NCAA's three divisions. That achievement propelled him to HoopDirt.com Division II Coach of the Week honors. MacDonald has also been recognized as a two-time Division II Coach of the Year from the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY), as well as receiving ECC and NABC District Coach of the Year (both for the 2018-19 season). He enters the 2021-22 season ranked 37th among active Division II head coaches for career victories.

MacDonald's tenure got started with a bang. In his return to Canisius' Koessler Athletic Center on November 11, 2014, he led the Wildcats to an 83-81 overtime win against the Division I Golden Griffins, a program he led for nine seasons.

His official Daemen debut came just days later as his Wildcats walloped Concordia (N.Y.), 88-50, in the opening round of the ECC-CACC Challenge. It served as a precursor to future success as the Wildcats have posted an 11-1 mark in the ECC-CACC Challenge with MacDonald at the helm.

Later that season, MacDonald helped the Wildcats achieve postseason success despite the loss of two starters to season-ending injuries. With Daemen still ineligible for ECC and NCAA Division II postseason, Daemen elected to partake in the United States Collegiate Athletic Association (USCAA) Division I National Championships in Uniontown, Pa., entering the tournament as the No. 1 overall seed. While there, MacDonald guided Daemen to wins over No. 8 Indiana-South Bend (69-63), No. 4 Concordia (Ala.) (68-63) and No. 3 Rochester (Mich.) (77-53) to capture the program's first USCAA national title, riding USCAA Division I Player of the Year and National Championships MVP Gerald Beverly to the tourney crown.

In the 2015-16 season - Daemen's first as a full-fledged NCAA Division II member - MacDonald's squad hit their stride after the calendar turned to January, scoring 15 wins in the final 19 games of the regular season. Included in the string was a miraculous 98-96 win over rival Roberts Wesleyan as the Wildcats erased a 22-point deficit over the final six minutes of the contest. After finishing with a 14-6 record in conference play, the Wildcats made their ECC tournament debut with a 103-102 overtime win over Mercy in the semifinals.

Daemen has finished third or better in the ECC standings in each of MacDonald's fist six seasons. They've qualified for the conference tournament in each of the five years they've been eligible, advancing to at least the semifinals every season and to the finals in 2016. MacDonald has also played a direct role in mentoring 10 players who account for 18 all-conference selections.

Home court success has been a large part of the program's success through the years, including the MacDonald Era. The Wildcats won their first nine home games under MacDonald, extending the

program's Lumsden Gymnasium winning streak to 44 straight games before it was snapped. The Wildcats have posted a 76-14 record in home games under MacDonald's guidance. They've set a new program benchmark for home wins in a season, posting identical 15-1 home records during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.

Before arriving at Daemen, MacDonald spent eight years (2006-14) leading the NCAA Division III program at Medaille where he transformed the Mavericks into a regional contender. Inheriting a program that went 4-46 in the two years prior to his arrival, MacDonald's version of the Mavericks averaged 18 wins per season, while advancing to the postseason six times.

Medaille's emergence as a Division III power in the Northeast was cemented in MacDonald's final five seasons there, as he led the Mavericks to more wins (101) than any other Division III team in New York State, while ranking 17th nationally in wins during the same time frame. MacDonald was named the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference Coach of the Year on four occasions (2006-07, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2011-12). He left as the school's all-time leader in wins (149) and winning percentage (.671).

Prior to his time at Medaille, MacDonald spent 18 years at Canisius, including a nine-year stint (1997-2006) as head coach. In that time, MacDonald guided the Golden Griffins to 108 wins which ranks him third in program history for coaching victories. While there, he was one of only five coaches in that program's storied history to orchestrate a 20-win season, and was named the 2000-01 BCANY Division I Co-Coach of the

Before being elevated to the head coaching post at Canisius, MacDonald worked as an assistant on the Griffs' coaching staff, first under Marty Marbach and later under John Beilein. As Beilein's top assistant, MacDonald helped Canisius reach the 1996 NCAA tournament in addition to two National Invitational Tournament appearances.

In addition to his coaching accomplishments, MacDonald brings a strong connection to the local community. His teams have been active with a number of community organizations in the greater Buffalo community and beyond, including the Boys and Girls Clubs of Buffalo, Blessed Sacrament Athletic Club and Coaches vs. Cancer. In August of 2020, MacDonald received the Jim Satalin Inspiration Award from the American Cancer Society of Western New York in recognition of his dedication and work on behalf of the Coaches vs. Cancer program.

MacDonald and several of his players have also worked with the Drug Enforcement Administration and Mayor Byron Brown's office on Game Changers, a nationally awarded program that provides academic and athletic opportunities for inner-city youths during the summer months.

A 1988 graduate of Saint Bonaventure University, MacDonald additionally serves Daemen as the Senior Associate Athletics Director for External Relations. In that role, MacDonald has raised more than \$500,000 for the College. He resides in Amherst with his wife, Maura (nee Heary). The couple has raised four children -Matthew, Patrick, Nicholas and Mark. Matthew served as team captain during his collegiate career at the University of Pennsylvania and is now a player development assistant with the Brooklyn Nets. Patrick was a Division III All-American while playing at the State University of New York Maritime College, and is now enlisted in the United States Navy. Nicholas is a junior on the basketball team at Daemen, and Mark is a sophomore attending Canisius High School.

DEFENDING THE DEN

Success on their home floor has been a staple of Daemen's rise within the NCAA Division II ranks. The Wildcats have won 10+ home games in eight of the last 10 seasons, including identical 15-1 records during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 campaigns which established a new program benchmark for homecourt victories. Dating back to the 2017-18 season, Daemen has won 42 of their last 46 home games. Since joining the ECC (2013-14 season), Daemen is 59-10 in home conference games (.855 win %). The Wildcats are also 70-13 at home during the program's NCAA era (.843 win %). In the past 21 seasons, the Wildcats have won 83% of all home games, going 225-46.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Guards Sean Fasoviro and Andrew Mason each made immediate contributions during their first season with the program in 2020-21. Fasoyiro was a first-team All-ECC and NABC All-District selection after finishing second on the team in scoring (13.9) and rebounding (7.1) while leading the squad in assists (3.9). Fasoyiro, a graduate transfer from Franklin Pierce, is competing in a fifth collegiate season with 97 games of playing experience under his belt to start the year. Mason burst on the scene as a freshman and started all 16 contests. He averaged 12.6 points and 6.1 rebounds per game while leading the ECC in three-point field goal accuracy (.487).

TEXAS-SIZED CHALLENGES

Daemen opened the season with three high-profile contests in Canyon, Texas as part of the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic held over Halloween weekend. The Wildcats knocked off Minnesota State Moorhead, 67-63, in the opener, thanks to the play of Nick MacDonald (17 points) and Andrew Sischo (16 points, 15 rebounds). The Dragons were ranked No. 25 in the D2SIDA preseason poll and picked to finish first in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. It marked the 18th time in the last 20 seasons that Daemen has started 1-0. A pair of losses to nationally ranked team followed. No. 4 Colorado Mesa got the best of the Wildcats, 76-65, using a 27-6 second-half spurt to erase a nine-point halftime deficit. Sischo was held to nine points, snapping a string of 67 consecutive double-figure games. The All-American big man was hampered by foul trouble and limited to 19 minutes - his lowest minute total since playing 10 against New York Tech on Dec. 16, 2018, a game he left due to an injury. Sischo returned to form in the tournament finale, finishing with 18 points and 15 boards, but it wasn't enough to lead Daemen past No. 3 West Texas A&M. In a rematch of last season's Elite Eight meeting. The Buffs came out on top again, this time by just three points (69-66). Sean Fasoyiro's tying three-point attempt fell short as the buzzer sounded. Both Sischo and Fasoyiro were named to the All-Tournament Team.

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

The Daemen program has been built on sustained success, winning at least 19 games in nine of the last 10 seasons. That span encompasses the end of Daemen's NAIA Era, its' NCAA transition period and the first six seasons of full NCAA Division II membership. The Wildcats have won 72% of their contests, going 208-82 in that span. Looking more recently, Daemen is 82-31 since the start of the 2017-18 season (.726 winning percentage).

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK

Daemen has earned three consecutive NCAA tournament berths. The Wildcats won 24 games (NCAA Era program record) and earned at-large bids to the NCAA tournament in 2019 and 2020. The Wildcats entered the 2021 tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Region and picked up their first-ever NCAA tourney win with an 81-69 defeat of third-seeded Bloomfield en route to the program's first regional championship and Elite Eight appearance.

DEGREE OF DIFFICULTY

Daemen's 2021-22 schedule will provide plenty of tests. The Wildcats are slated to play games against seven teams who were ranked in either the NABC or D2SIDA preseason national polls: Minnesota State Moorhead, Colorado Mesa, West Texas A&M, Mercyhurst, West Liberty, Saint Anselm, St. Thomas Aquinas. Daemen has recorded two wins over top-25 ranked teams in each of the last three seasons.





LAST GAME RECAP

Sischo, Bradley Lead Wildcats To Win In ECC Opener

STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. - With the frontcourt duo of *Andrew Sischo* (Guilderland, N.Y.) and *Ryan Bradley* (Niagara Falls, N.Y.) leading the way, the Daemen men's basketball team provided a rude welcome to East Coast Conference newcomer Staten Island, cruising past the Dolphins 80-61 at the CSI Sports and Recreation Center this evening. It marked the ECC season opener for both teams, and the first-ever ECC contest for CSI which is transitioning to the NCAA Division II ranks from Division III.

The Wildcats picked up their first victory since October 29, snapping a three-game slide to improve to 2-3 on the season. Coach *Mike MacDonald*'s team is off to a 1-0 start in ECC play for the fourth straight season. It was arguably the Wildcats' best offensive performance of the season, as they enjoyed season-highs in points, field goals (30), field goal percentage (.476) and assists (14).

CSI (0-4, 0-1 ECC) is left searching for their first win of the season. The Dolphins, who opted out of the 2020-21 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, last won a game on February 10, 2020 (66-61 over Brooklyn College).

Sischo and Bradley had their way with the interior of the CSI defense right from the jump ball. The tandem played a pivotal role in helping Daemen outscore the Dolphins 40-18 in the paint, while also posting a 44-25 rebounding advantage.

With Daemen dominating the interior, the Wildcats took less than five minutes to open up a 10-point lead, scoring 14 of the game's first 18 points. A 16-3 Daemen run, including eight points from forward Bradley, further cemented the Wildcats' grip, putting them ahead 37-17. The Daemen lead reached 20 points (42-22) on a three-pointer by <u>Nick MacDonald</u> (Amherst, N.Y.), but CSI closed the opening stanza on a 10-5 spurt to pull within 15 points (47-32) at the break.

The Daemen lead quickly ballooned back over 20 points as the Wildcats opened the second half with a 10-2 spurt, including three-pointers from *Ryan Salzberg* (Manlius, N.Y.) and *Sean Fasoyiro* (Houston, Texas). Daemen's largest advantage came at the 10:16 mark when a layup by *Joey Atkins* (Watervliet, N.Y.) put them ahead by 27 points (69-42).

IMPACT PLAYERS

- Sischo scored 18 of his 24 points in the first half, and finished 10-for-15 from the field. He added 11 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season and the 64th of his career.
- Bradley, who made his second straight start, had a night to remember, finishing with career-highs in points (15) and rebounds (nine) while flirting
 with a double-double. He shot 7-for-11 from the field and added two steals and two blocks.
- Salzberg, MacDonald and Kyle Harris (Buffalo, N.Y.) combined for six of the Wildcats' nine three-pointers. Salzberg finished with eight points in
 his return to the lineup after missing the previous game vs. Mercyhurst. MacDonald netted nine points and dished three assists. Harris finished
 with six points and a season-high five assists.
- Michael Ashley came off the bench to lead CSI, finishing with 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting to go with six rebounds in just 23 minutes of action. Austin Mick chipped in 15 points, including a trio of three-pointers.

GAME NOTES

- Daemen returns 11 players, including all five starters, from their 2020-21 team that won the NCAA Division II East Region Championship and advanced to the Elite Eight.
- Tonight's win was Daemen's first since their season opener a 67-63 defeat of Minnesota State Moorhead in the first round of the Division II Conference Commissioners Association Tip-Off Classic in Canyon, Texas.
- The game was just Daemen's second since emerging from a COVID-19-related pause in team activities. The Wildcats had four games canceled from Nov. 8-13 due to the shutdown.
- All three of Daemen's setbacks this season have come against nationally ranked opponents. Tonight's win allowed the Wildcats to avoid their first four-game losing streak since the 2010-11 season.
- Daemen head coach <u>Mike MacDonald</u> is now just two wins shy of 400 for his career. The veteran bench boss owns a 398-286 record across 25 seasons. MacDonald ranks 37th among active Division II coaches in career wins. He has led Daemen to a 141-60 record since taking the reins of the program in 2014.
- The Wildcats are 6-3 all-time in ECC season openers.
- While the Wildcats regained the services of their starting point guard Salzberg, they remained without starting guard <u>Andrew Mason</u> (Webster, N.Y.) who missed his second straight game. Mason is averaging 12.3 points in 19 career games.
- Sischo has now scored 10+ points in 70 of his last 71 games. Tonight's outing marked the 61st 20-point game of his career.

Daemen makes its long-awaited home debut this Saturday, November 27 when they host regional foe St. Rose for a 1 p.m. tip-off.
