NO. 2 BRUINS OPEN REGULAR SEASON AT DAEMEN COLLEGE IN NEW YORK — UCLA (0-0), ranked No. 2 in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) preseason poll, will open the 2020 regular season with a match at Daemen College (0-0) of Buffalo, N.Y. on Thursday at 3 p.m. PT. Daemen is its second year as a program and is the only NCAA Division II men's volleyball program north of the Mason-Dixon Line. The Bruins will then travel south to meet George Mason (0-0), site of the 2020 NCAA Championships in Fairfax, Va. for a 4 p.m. match. It will be the season-opener for the Patriots who tied for second last season in the Eastern Intercollegiate Volleyball Association (EIVA) with Penn State at 10-4. UCLA concludes the road trip at No. 10 Princeton (The Tigers open their season at UCl on Dec. 29 and at USC on Jan. 2) on Monday at 11 a.m. PT. The Tigers won the EIVA regular season (13-1 record) last season and edged Penn State in five sets to win the post-season tournament and the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

LAST MEETING -- This is UCLA's first meeting ever with Daemen College. The Bruins met George Mason in the 2018 season and swept the Patriots 25-17, 25-13, 25-20 in Pauley Pavilion. UCLA last played at George Mason in the 2016 season, a 25-23, 25-12, 25-20 victory. UCLA opened the 2019 season against Princeton with a 25-17, 26-24, 25-18 Bruin win. Princeton and UCLA have played in each of the last five seasons, all Bruin wins. NOTES -- UCLA is ranked No. 2 to open the season for the second consecutive season ... The Bruins finished No. 7 in the final 2019 AVCA Coaches poll after seeing their season end with a loss in the semifinals of the MPSF Tournament ... UCLA has ended a season ranked No. 1 in the AVCA poll a record nine times (1987, 1989, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2006) ... In 2019, the Bruins finished 9-9 against teams ranked in the AVCA poll at the time of the match ... Daenan Gyimah has earned first-team AVCA All-America honors in each of the last two seasons and also has been the recipient of the Ryan Millar Award as the nation's top middle attacker ... Gyimah hit at least .400 in 17 matches last season and finished fourth in the nation with a .432 mark ... He set a school record with a .917 hitting percentage against McKendree last season (11k-0e-12att) ... As a team, UCLA outhit teams .352 to . 195 margin in its 19 wins.

SCHEDULE --- The first home match for the Bruins will be on Jan. 30 against No. 10 Princeton. UCLA will host matches this season against No. 3 BYU, No. 4 Long Beach State, No. 5 UC Santa Barbara, No. 7 Stanford, No. 9 Pepperdine, No. 12 USC, and No. 13 CSUN. The Bruins will go on the road to battle No. 3 BYU, No. 4 Long Beach State, No. 5 UC Santa Barbara, No. 7 Stanford, No. 9 Pepperdine, No. 10 Princeton, No. 12 USC, No. 13 CSUN and No. 15 Penn State. ON THE ROAD -- UCLA was 7-7 on the road last season, with an 2-1 mark in neutral site contests.

AT HOME -- UCLA was 10-1 at home (7-1 in Pauley) last season ... Over the past four seasons, UCLA is 38-5 in Pauley (2016: 10-1, 2017: 8-1, 2018: 13-2, 2019: 7-1) ... The last team not named Long Beach State (which won a match last season in Pauley and a couple of matches in 2018) to defeat UCLA in Pauley was CSUN in February of 2017 (note: the Bruins did lose three home matches in the Wooden Center after the 2017 CSUN loss).

NCAA STATS -- Last season, UCLA finished fifth in the nation in hitting percentage (.323), fifth in aces per set (1.73) and sixth in kills per set (12.85). The Bruins return Daenan Gyimah who ranked fourth in the NCAA in hitting a year ago at .435...They lose Micah Ma'a who ranked tied for second in aces average at 0.638

MPSF -- Each MPSF team has 12 conference matches. The MPSF Championship Tournament begins with seeds two, three and four hosting a quarterfinal match (April 18). Seed one receives a bye. The semifinals (Apr. 23) and final (Apr. 25) will be on the home floor of the No. 1 seed, with the winner earning the automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament which will be hosted by George Mason. The Opening Round and Play-in matches of the NCAA Tournament will be held between May 1-5 at sites to be determined. The Bruins will open the MPSF schedule on February 6 with a match at pre-season favorite BYU.

# BY THE NUMBERS

- Daenan Gyimah finished fourth in the NCAA in hitting percentage in 2019 (.432) ... He hit over .400 in 17 matches last season, including a streak of 13 straight matches ... In 2018, Gyimah led the NCAA in hitting percentage at .528.
- Daenan Gyimah, who has been the recipient of the past two Ryan Millar Award as the nation's top middle attacker, set a school record with a .917 hitting percentage at McKendree (11k-0k-12 att) ... the old mark was .900 held by several players, last Allan Vince in 2005 v. UC Irvine.
- Daenan Gyimah was named a 2020 pre-season All-America selection by Off the Block .... Gyimah was also named to the Ryan Millar Watch List.
- Austin Matautia is on the 2020 Karch Kiraly Watch List which recognizes the nation's top outside hitter.
- Mads Kved Jensen is on the 2020 Llov Ball Watch List as one of the nation's top setters.
- UCLA was 19-0 when it hit for a higher % than the opponent in 2019... In 11 home matches in 2019, UCLA hit at a .323 clip vs. .213 for opponents ... In 14 true away matches - UCLA hit .320 to .305 for opponents.
- UCLA was 9-9 last year vs. teams ranked in the AVCA poll at the time of the match.
- . UCLA utilized 12 different starting lineups in the course of the 2019 season.
- In wins in the 2019 season, the Bruins out hit opponents .352 to .195 ... In losses, the opponent hit .382 against the Bruins who hit .268.
- The Bruins were 9-0 in 2019 when holding the opponent at or below .200.
- The Bruins equaled the school mark with seven aces in a set (second set) in a home match against UC San Diego last season.
- Brandon Rattray registered a career-best 24 kills at Stanford ... Rattray finished ninth in the MPSF in Points Average (3.87), Kills Average (3.33) ... He finished with double-digit kills in 15 matches.
- Grant Maleski, who had 23 starts in 2019, hit .300 or better in 15 matches and recorded multiple aces in five matches ... He compiled a season-best 9 kills at UCSB and totaled a career-best 7 block assists in win over Stanford ... He had a career-best three aces vs. USC and Concordia and a streak of 8 straight matches with at least one ace in 2019.
- MB Matt Younggren led or tied for the team lead in blocks in four of the final five matches of 2019 ... He registered a UCLA career-best seven kills at Pepperdine ... He posted a season-high six block assists in the back-to-back MPSF home matches vs. BYU and Stanford.
- Libero Cole Pender registered a 94% serve receive percentage on 494 attempts in 2019. He was named to the MPSF All-Freshman team.
- Austin Matautia injured an ankle against Penn State in match 20 of 2019 and sat out the balance of the season ... He hit .343 over the last five matches of the season he played in ... He was MPSF Offensive POW after leading UCLA to wins over Pepperdine (2/27) and Grand Canyon (3/1) ... He posted a career-best 22 kills in the match vs. Pepperdine.
- · Austin Matautia and Brandon Rattray were selected to the U.S. team for the World University Games held last summer in Italy.
- True freshmen Kyle Vom Steeg, Marcus Partain, Alex Knight, Merrick McHenry, Cole Power and Ethan Hill were each named to the 2019 VolleyballMag.com Fab 50 list.
- Freshman Alex Knight was named the 2019 Volleyballmag.com National High School Player of the Year ... Played on the U.S. Youth National Team which won the silver medal at the NORCECA U19 championships in summer 2018 and 2019.
- Freshman Mads Keyd Jensen was named the top setter in the Danish League for 2018 and 2019.
- Freshman Cole Ketrzynski helped lead teams to the 2018 and 2019 Privincial and National Indoor Championships in Canada.
- Last off-season, Head Coach John Speraw directed the U.S. Men's National Team to qualification for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics by winning their Intercontinental Qualifying pool, added a bronze medal at the FIVB World Cup and a silver in the Volleyball Nation's League.
- Assistant Coach John Hawks was coach for the U.S. Men's Volleyball team which earned a silver medal in the NORCECA Continental Championships, guiding a team which featured Mitch Stahl and Micah Ma'a.
- Assistant Coach Spencer McLachlin served on the coahing staff for U.S. Men's Volleyball teams which competed in the U21 Pan American Cup and the NORCECA Champions Cup.

# **HEAD COACH JOHN SPERAW - YEAR EIGHT AT UCLA**

UCLA head men's volleyball coach John Speraw, winner of three NCAA titles and an Olympic Bronze medal as a head coach, is in his eighth season at the helm in Westwood. He was the first individual to win an NCAA MVB championship as a head coach (2007, 2009 and 2012 at UC Irvine), an assistant coach (1996, 1998, 2000 at UCLA) and as a player (1993 and 1995 at UCLA). He has guided the Bruins into the National Championship Tournament in two of the last four seasons, including a trip to the Championship match in 2018.

Speraw, who was a member of the 2018 Class of the SoCal Indoor Volleyball Hall of Fame, achieved milestone wins No. 100 at UCLA and No. 300 overall during the 2018 campaign. In addition, he was named the 2018 VolleyballMag.com men's college Coach of the Year after leading his Bruins into the NCAA championship match. UCLA finished 26-8, the most wins by the program since 2006.

Speraw, who was voted the 2006 AVCA Coach of the Year, was named head coach at UCLA in June of 2012 and has tutored 39 All-Americans in his career. He came to UCLA from UC Irvine where he led the Anteaters to three NCAA titles, two Mountain Pacific Sports Federation regular season titles (2006, 2009) and two MPSF Tournament crowns (2007, 2012). He guided UCl to a 199-106 record in ten seasons.

Speraw has also enjoyed an extensive coaching resume with the U.S. National team. After serving as Assistant Coach for the 2008 (Gold in Beijing) and 2012 Olympics (advanced to the quarterfinals at London), Speraw was elevated to head coach of the U.S. Men's Volleyball National Team in March of 2013. The U.S. qualified for the 2016 Olympic Games by winning the 2015 World Cup competition and went on to capture the Bronze medal at the Rio Games. In the summer of 2018, Speraw directed the U.S. Men's National Team to its first FIVB World Championship medal in 24 years when it beat Serbia, 23-25, 25-17, 32-30, 25-19 for the bronze in Turin, Italy. The U.S. men have already qualifed for the 2020 Tokyo Games, winning their Intercontinental Qualifying Pool last summer.
