➤ FASTBREAK POINTS

1. Daemen makes their NCAA tournament debut Saturday in the regional semifinals. The second-seeded Wildcats will face the winner of Friday's quarterfinal contest between third-seeded Georgian Court and sixth-seeded Concordia (N.Y.). Daemen enters tournament play with a 12-2 overall record and are 8-1 since the start of February.

2. Daemen's NCAA tournament debut comes exactly a year from what was to be the program's first-ever NCAA tournament game. After winning the 2020 ECC championship and being awarded the No. 7 seed in the East Regional, Daemen was set to face second-seeded Stonehill in the opening round of the NCAA tournament before it was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

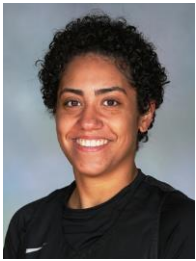
3. Last weekend, Daemen finished as the runner-up in the 2021 ECC tournament held at Lumsden Gymnasium. After defeating fourth-seeded Molloy (52-42) in a rematch of the 2020 title game, the Wildcats came up just short to long-time rival Roberts Wesleyan (59-53) in the tournament final. Daemen's **Caroline White** and **Katie Titus** were named to the all-tournament team.

3. The Wildcats are currently ranked among the best teams in the country. The Wildcats enter the NCAA tournament at No. 16 in the D2SIDA national media poll and No. 15 in the WBCA Division II coaches' poll. These are the final national polls being released until after the conclusion of the NCAA tournament.

5. Daemen has been among one of the best defensive teams in the country this season. They rank third in scoring defense and seventh in field goal percentage defense, allowing just 51.2 points per game on 32.5% shooting. The Wildcats have held seven of their last nine opponents to less than 50 points. Dating back to last season, the Wildcats are 33-3 when holding opponents to 65 points or less.

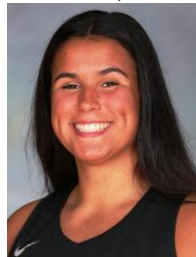

➤ #1 DOMINICAN SCOUTING REPORT

- Dominican earned the top seed in the East Region after defeating previously unbeaten Georgian Court to claim the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference championship. The Lady Chargers enter the NCAA tournament with a 12-1 overall record and a 12-game winning streak.
- The Lady Chargers, who are making the second NCAA tournament appearance in program history, are led by head coach Bill Diener who has led the program to a 148-151 overall record in 11 seasons.
- Dominican returns nine players, including seven with starting experience, from last year's team that finished 15-14 overall and 13-6 in CACC play.
- Dominican boasts six players averaging at least 7.5 points per game, led by the duo of Taylor Tomlinson (11.6 ppg) and Khay'la Latimer (10.8 ppg). Tomlinson scored a season-high 25 points and grabbed 10 boards in DC's CACC championship victory. Both Tomlinson and Latimer were named to the All-CACC team.
- Dominican is among the best passing teams in the country. They are averaging 18.1 assists per game - fifth-best in Division II.

➤ #3 GEORGIAN COURT SCOUTING REPORT

- Georgian Court is making the first NCAA tournament appearance in program history after claiming the Central Athletic Collegiate Conference regular season title. The Lions enter the NCAA tournament with an 8-1 overall record and are coming off an 81-65 loss to Dominican in last weekend's CACC tournament final. The loss snapped GCU's 11-game winning streak that dated back to last season.
- The Lions are led by head coach Jasmina Perazic, a former All-American player at Maryland, who has led the program to its first winning season at the Division II level.
- Freshman guard Anyssa Fields took the CACC by storm this season, winning the league's Player and Defensive Player of the Year honors. She leads CACC in field goals (68-138), total rebounds (101), points (170), and points per game (18.9).
- The Lions are also getting double-figure scoring from Tian Addison (12.6 ppg) and Savawn Hughes (10.8 ppg).
- The Lions are blocking 5.3 shots per game, seventh-best in Division II. They are also grabbing 45.1 rebounds per game (11th in Division II) and swiping 10.1 steals per game.

➤ #6 CONCORDIA (N.Y.) SCOUTING REPORT

- Concordia is making the first NCAA tournament appearance in program history, and it comes in the program's final season. Concordia officials announced in late January that the school was shut its doors at the completion of the 2020-21 academic year.
- The Clippers are led by seventh-year head coach Christie Tomasino Conforti who has led the program to its first winning season since 1986-87. The Clippers enter NCAA tournament play with a 6-5 overall record after advancing to the semifinal round of the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference tournament where they suffered a 76-57 loss to Georgian Court - their first NCAA tournament opponent.
- Sophomore guard Marigona Bacaliu was named to the All-CACC team and is averaging a team-high 15.2 points per game game. Bacaliu sank a team-best 23 three-pointers this season, and scored a season-high 35 points in Concordia's season-opening 68-65 win over Bloomfield.
- Additional production is coming from senior guard Shanice Graves (9.2 ppg), junior guard Saundra Cleckley (7.8 ppg) and sophomore forward Jaayden Lafontant (7.7 ppg).

➤ #4 AMERICAN INT'L SCOUTING REPORT

- The AIC Yellow Jackets are back in the NCAA tournament field for the first time since 2016 and for the 12th time in program history. The AIC program boasts two regional championships (2002, 2006) and one national runner-up finish (2006) in its history.
- Head coach Kristen Hutchison has led AIC to a 219-172 record in 14 seasons at the helm. She has her team positioned with a 7-1 record entering NCAA tournament play. The Yellow Jackets' lone loss came against Mercyhurst (64-55) on Jan. 31, and they've picked up four wins since then.
- The Yellow Jackets are allowing just 52.1 points per game (5th in Division II) on 33.6% shooting (9th in Division II).
- AIC returns eight players from their 2019-20 team, all of who hold starting experience.
- Senior guard Destine Perry leads a trio of double-figure scorers by averaging 16.5 points per game. Perry has scored 10+ points in seven of eight games this season, including 32 in a recent win over Franklin Pierce.
- Additional production is coming from Kyla Smith (12.9 ppg) and Kayla Robinson (11.7 ppg).

➤ #5 ROBERTS WESLEYAN SCOUTING REPORT

- Roberts Wesleyan is making its first-ever appearance in the NCAA tournament. The Redhawks come in riding a seven-game winning streak, including a 59-53 win over Daemen last Sunday to claim their first East Coast Conference championship.
- Head coach Kevin Clifford has posted 148 wins across 14 seasons leading four different programs, including a 40-36 mark in three seasons at RWC.
- The Redhawks return two starters from their 2019-20 team that went 15-13 overall. They enter the NCAA tournament with a 10-6 overall record.
- Paige McCormick, a transfer from Division I UMass, leads the team in scoring, averaging 13.7 points per game.
- Dimitra Gkizani is contributing 12.4 points and a team-high 7.7 rebounds per contest.
- Taryn Wilson has sank 35 three-pointers and is producing 10.9 points per game. She was named the Most Outstanding Player of the ECC tournament after scoring 19 points in the final round.

TICKET PUNCHED: DAEMEN WOMEN'S HOOPS CLAIMS SECOND STRAIGHT NCAA BID

Wildcats are number two seed in East Region, receive bye into regional semifinals

AMHERST, N.Y. – One year removed from having their postseason hopes dashed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Daemen is returning to the big stage. The Wildcats are dancing their way back to the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Championship which gets underway later this week with regional tournaments across the country, including here at Daemen's Lumsden Gymnasium. The full 48-team NCAA tournament bracket was announced late this evening in a selection show broadcast on NCAA.com.



The tournament field is broken down into eight regions, consisting of only six teams each for this season due to the pandemic. Daemen is one of the 32 at-large bids selected by the Division II Women's Basketball Committee and now join the 16 conference champions that earned automatic qualifying bids to the tournament. Last month, Daemen was awarded the right to host the East Regional from March 12-15.

Daemen is the No. 2 seed in the East Region and the Wildcats will make their long-awaited NCAA tournament debut in the regional semifinals Saturday, March 13. As the No. 2 seed, Daemen has earned a first-round bye. The Wildcats will face the winner of third-seeded Georgian Court and sixth-seeded Concordia (N.Y.) which meet in an opening round game Friday, March 12.

Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference champion Dominican (N.Y.) is the No. 1 seed in the East Region. The Chargers await the winner of Friday's other first-round matchup between fourth-seeded American International and fifth-seeded Roberts Wesleyan.

Game times and broadcast information for the East Regional will be announced later this week.

Daemen, which earned an automatic bid to the 2020 NCAA tournament before it was shelved by the pandemic, will enter this year's tournament with a 12-2 record. After capturing their second straight ECC regular-season title with a 9-0 conference mark, the Wildcats finished as the runner-up in the ECC tournament held this past week. Daemen defeated fourth-seeded Molloy, 52-42, in Thursday's semifinal round, a rematch of the 2020 ECC championship game. Then, in Saturday's tournament final, Daemen saw their eight-game winning streak snapped at the hands of second-seeded Roberts Wesleyan, 59-53. Dating back to the 2018-2019 season, the Wildcats have won 27 of their last 31 games.

Daemen's potential semifinal round opponents both hail from the CACC. Georgian Court will enter the NCAA tournament with an 8-1 overall record after being upset in the CACC tournament Saturday by Dominican, 81-65. Daemen and Georgian Court have not met since the 1993-94 season - the only all-time meeting between the two. Concordia comes into the NCAA tournament with a 6-5 overall record. Daemen defeated the Clippers 70-47 in the teams' first-ever meeting last season. A full semifinal-round preview will be posted to daemenwildcats.com later this week.

Winners of the eight regional tournaments will advance to the Elite Eight which is slated for March 23-26 in Columbus, Ohio at the Greater Columbus Convention Center.





JENEPPER BANKER

HEAD COACH • FIFTH SEASON • SPRINGFIELD, '85

Jenepher Banker will embark on her fifth season as the head women's basketball coach at Daemen College in 2020-21 as she continues to build Western New York's premier NCAA Division II program. Banker was introduced as the fourth head coach in the modern era of the program in 2016 and has since led the Wildcats to a 76-49 overall record and a 55-26 mark in East Coast Conference play.

The 2019-20 season marked Daemen's finest since transitioning to the ECC and NCAA Division II. Banker guided the squad to a 23-5 overall record - the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13 - as well as a share of the ECC regular season championship and the ECC tournament title. They did so by combining stingy defense with solid offensive production, especially from behind the three-point arc. The Wildcats allowed just 55.0 points per game, ranking 13th in the country, and went 9-1 when holding opponents to less than 50 points. On the offensive end, Daemen set program records for three-pointers made in a game (20 vs. Queens on January 10) and season (238) and ranked first in the ECC for three-pointers made per game (8.5). Daemen's +14.1 scoring margin also topped the ECC and ranked 30th nationally.

The team's success in 2019-20 included a 13-game winning streak spanning some 69 days - the longest winning streak of the program's NCAA Division II era. The Wildcats also posted a 9-0 record at home, going undefeated for the third time in program history and for the first time since 2007-08. The Wildcats rose as high as No. 5 in the Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA) East Region media poll as well as the official NCAA regional rankings released late in the season by the Regional Advisory Committee.

After going 13-3 during the conference regular season, the Wildcats experienced postseason success with two wins at the ECC tournament which was played at the UDC Sports Complex in Washington, D.C. Second-seeded Daemen knocked off third-seeded New York Tech in the semifinals, 76-56, on March 7. A day later, Banker led the Wildcats to a 68-56 win over fourth-seeded Molloy in the finals, riding the double-double performance (24 points, 13 rebounds) of sophomore forward Katie Titus who was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

The conference tournament title came with an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. Daemen was awarded the No. 7 seed in the East Region, and was set to make its NCAA tournament debut on March 13 against second-seeded Stonehill. However, the tournament was canceled on March 12 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The groundwork for a championship season was laid in the years prior. Inheriting a team that won nine games in the season prior to her arrival, Banker has presided over Daemen's steady rise in the win column. She led the team to 11 wins in her debut season and 12 more during the 2017-18 campaign which included the program's first ECC tournament berth.

In 2018-19, Banker led the Wildcats to an 18-10 overall record and a 15-3 mark in conference games. The 15 conference wins established a new benchmark for Daemen's ECC era as the Wildcats placed second in the ECC standings. The Wildcats also achieved their first-ever regional ranking at the Division II level that

season, debuting in the D2SIDA East Region media poll in a tie for No. 10 on February 4. They later debuted at No. 10 in the official NCAA regional poll released on February 20. Daemen's ascent into the regional conversation came in the midst of winning 14 of their final 15 regular season contests, including a streak of 11 in a row. Banker picked up her 100th win as a collegiate head coach along the way, a 79-47 defeat of conference foe District of Columbia on January 27.

Over her first four seasons at the helm, Banker has played an integral role in the development of seven all-conference players. Those players account for 10 total all-conference selections, including first-team picks Sarah Saba (2017, 2018), Katie Titus (2019), Tiara Filbert (2020) and Caroline White (2020). The team's four all-conference selections in 2020 are the most of the program's Division II era. Additionally, Titus was named the ECC Rookie of the Year in 2019 to become the first Daemen player to receive a major award from the conference.

Banker holds more than 30 years of coaching experience at various levels, ranging from Division I to high school. Her first collegiate experience came as an assistant coach at Iowa State University, then of the Big Eight Conference, from 1986-88, and later as an assistant at Canisius College from 1993-95.

Between assistant coaching stops, Banker served as the head coach at Penn State-Behrend in Erie, Pa. While there, she led the Lions' NCAA Division III program to a 67-61 overall record, including a 41-12 mark in her final two seasons. Her 1991-92 team went 23-4, winning the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) South Region championship. That season, her team garnered Penn State-Behrend's first-ever national ranking in any sport. She still ranks second all-time in coaching victories, and was inducted into Penn State-Behrend's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1994.

Later, Banker settled at the high school level, coaching the varsity team at Grand Island High School from 1998-2013, building the Lady Vikings into a regional contender with seven Section VI championships, four appearances in the Far West Regional, and one appearance at the New York State final four. During her tenure, Banker's teams were recognized with the New York State Scholar-Athlete Team Award for 15 straight seasons, and she developed 10 players that went on to play college basketball, as well as four of the five 1,000-point scorers in school history.

In addition, Banker has also coached twice in the Empire State Games, formerly a set of annual Olympic-style competitions for amateur athletes from the state of New York.

Banker, who played collegiately and was an Academic All-American and 1,000-point scorer at Springfield College (Mass.), graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1985 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education. She would later add a Master of Science Degree in Athletic Administration from Iowa State in 1988. After serving as a physical education instructor at Iowa State, Penn State-Behrend and Canisius, she had, since 1998, been a physical education teacher in the Grand Island School District where she has also served as the Director of Community Education.

She resides in Grand Island with her husband, Brett. Together, the couple has raised two children. Their son, Kolby, is the head women's soccer coach at Erie Community College. Their daughter, Kallie, is a former Division I basketball player at both the University of Rhode Island and the University of Vermont, who now serves as Daemen's top assistant.

All in the Family: Bankers Embrace Time Together with Daemen Women's Hoops

AMHERST, N.Y. - Parents coaching their children is common in sports, mostly in the youth to high school levels and occasionally at the college level. But a parent coaching alongside their son or daughter at any level – let alone, the collegiate level? A rarity.

That's what makes the mother-daughter dynamic of head coach Jenepher Banker and assistant coach Kallie Banker with Daemen women's basketball over the past three seasons and counting a unique feat across the East Coast Conference – and the NCAA coaching landscape itself. Since joining forces in the 2017-18 season (Jenepher's second season as head coach), the Wildcats have posted a 53-32 record and hoisted its first ECC Tournament trophy in program history earlier this year.

Describing their coaching tenure on Main Street so far as a "passionate and rewarding" experience, the Bankers have a mutual appreciation of each other and their present opportunity.

"It's been really amazing to work with my mom but also (with) someone who is so passionate and great at what she's doing," said Kallie, a former Division I point guard at the University of Rhode Island and the University of Vermont. "It's been an amazing learning experience so I'm extremely happy and blessed to have gotten the opportunity."

"It's fantastic and something I'll remember forever, so I'm really happy that we got this opportunity," added coach Banker. "It's great to see her every day and talk basketball every day."

Part of an athletic family, basketball became the bond for the Banker women fairly quickly through multiple local basketball camps and driving together to AAU tournaments on the weekends. When she was in grade school and middle school, Kallie rode the bus to Grand Island High School to watch her mom coach the Vikings' varsity girls' basketball team. Soon, Kallie made the varsity team as a seventh grader and learned from then-senior – and future Daemen player – Courtney Donovan how to be a varsity athlete. In her first varsity game, Kallie made the game-winning shot on the baseline off a pass from the double-teamed Donovan – a moment which still stands out to her mom. Together, the Banker duo and the Vikings won three straight Section VI Class A

championships and advanced to the New York State Final Four in the 2010-11 season, Kallie's junior year.

Similar to what the Wildcats are experiencing now, the Bankers said their success at Grand Island was a collaborative effort from the starting five down to the last on the bench.

"I think it started with hard work and a dream and I think that (junior) year was a lot of hard work and a lot of passion behind that," said Kallie. "I think what makes a good team 'good,' at any level, is that goal that you're all striving for together and that passion to be able to do whatever it takes to get that job done."

Before accepting the assistant coaching role in the 2017-18 season, Kallie almost suited up for the Wildcats herself as she had a fifth and final year of eligibility. But with her growing interest in coaching with her mom along with enrolling for a law degree at the University of the Buffalo, finding this balance was something she couldn't refuse.

"I always wanted to find a career, where I could compete at all times," said Kallie, a third-year UB Law student who starts her final semester in mere weeks. "By nature, I'm a little aggressive, which our team would probably co-sign. I always wanted to be arguing in a productive manner. I wanted to work hard. I'm extremely motivated. I just felt that law was a position where I could do all the things I felt I was best at and it would challenge me every day. I'm really happy that I decided to do it."

While Banker said her daughter already had a high level of self-confidence, the growth she's noticed from Kallie as a coach has been impressive, describing her as "an incredibly outstanding coach."

"It's honestly, I think, as much natural as anything else," said Jenepher. "(Kallie's) incredibly talented at teaching different things. She also has great enthusiasm. When she comes into the gym, she kind of lights it up and is very enthusiastic and motivating but she's also a very good teacher. She holds our players to a really high standard, which they respond to."

"My role in practice, I think, is to be more of an enforcer," Kallie added. "Coach, by nature, is more quieter, so we balance each other out well, I think, on the court. My biggest role is to hold them accountable while being enthusiastic throughout practice."

The 2020 off-season has been one unlike any other due to ever-changing COVID-19 protocols. And while frustration has amassed at times, Banker has advised her team the following since September: "One day at a time, and when today's over, we'll see what tomorrow brings."



"We are one of the lucky programs to have an opportunity," said the head coach. "Basketball is so much a thread to who they are and what they do, players and coaches, really. Regardless of how many people are in a pod and how many people are on a court and what kind of drills we have to do that day based on that, there's still that common thread. We are appreciative that we are one of those programs that are having that opportunity, even if it's not normal and if we don't have our entire team."

So, what is the key to the Bankers' coaching success at Daemen? Establishing boundaries at home. If you're at home, don't talk about what's going on at work. Focus on spending time with family instead.

"I think my brother (Kolby) and dad (Brett) have enough basketball talk to last a lifetime," said Kallie. "When we're together as a family, we don't really spend a lot of time talking about basketball. I think, both as a player and a coach, I think it's been a really good balance."

Whether it's a high-stakes moment like winning the ECC title or a funny moment like trying to find a Florida restaurant that could serve them on Thanksgiving night, the Bankers said their time coaching at Daemen has provided them a lifetime of memories.

For other family coaching duos, the Bankers said enjoying the time together should be the top priority.

"Be appreciative for the time you get because Coach and I – now more than ever before – spend a lot of time together and it's amazing," said Kallie. "A lot of people don't get that opportunity with their parents after they move out or move on. I'm very appreciative of it but I'm also really appreciative of being able to grow a program. That has been a really amazing experience to do alongside my mom."

6. Senior forward **Caroline White** has been among the most well-rounded players in the ECC this season. The ECC Player of the Year and All-ECC first team selection ranks among the ECC leaders in scoring, rebounding, three-point shooting and field goal percentage. White, who enters the tournament just 21 points shy of 1,000 for her career, is one of four Daemen players to earn All-ECC recognition this season, joining fellow first-teamers **Katie Titus** and **Tiara Filbert** and second-teamer **Mickayla Ivy**.

7. Junior forward **Mickayla Ivy** has really come on since early February. In the past nine games, Ivy has reached double figures four times and is contributing 11.7 points and 7.7 rebounds per game in that span.

8. Daemen has been without redshirt senior guard **Tiara Filbert** for the past six games. An All-ECC first team selection, Filbert is averaging 13.3 points per game this season, and earlier became the 25th player in program history to reach 1,000 points.

9. After a pair of wins against St. Thomas Aquinas Feb. 27-28, Daemen won their second straight ECC regular season title and finished with a 9-0 mark. Daemen finished unbeaten in conference play for the third time in program history and the first time since 2003-04.

10. Daemen is coming off a 23-5 campaign that resulted in the program's first ECC championship and NCAA tournament berth. The Wildcats have won 27 of their last 31 games dating back to last season and are 49-9 dating back to the 2018-19 season.

DAEMEN QUICK FACTS

Daemen returns 11 players overall, including seven letter-winners and three starters, from last year's team that finished 23-5 overall and shared the ECC regular season title (13-3) before defeating third-seeded New York Tech and fourth-seeded Molloy to capture the program's first-ever ECC Tournament crown. Daemen enters the 2020-2021 season as the favorite in the ECC. The defending champion Wildcats were picked first in the ECC preseason poll for the first time since joining the league in 2013.

HELLO, MY NAME IS...

Daemen earned its first-ever berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament last season. By comparison, the other seven teams that qualified from the East Region had made a combined 67 appearances. Due to COVID-19 protocols, the tournament was cancelled.

POLL POSITION

After being ranked No.1 in the D2SIDA East Region media poll for a program-best six straight weeks, the longest stretch in program history, Daemen is now under consideration for championship selection heading into the post-season. Daemen remained ranked No. 9 in the D2SIDA national media poll this week for the second straight week and are nationally ranked for the eighth straight week. Also this week, the Wildcats stayed at No. 12 in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Division II top 25 coaches' poll, marking this the fifth straight week the team has been ranked in both Division II national polls. The Wildcats have been ranked in 21 successive D2SIDA regional polls, a span that dates back to January 2018.

HISTORIC START

The Wildcats won 21 of their first 24 games last season, which ranks as the best start of their NCAA era and their best start overall since opening the 2003–04 season by winning 26 of their first 29 games. The Wildcats won 13 straight games last year, which is a new program record for most consecutive wins during the program's NCAA era. It was the longest winning streak overall since the 2007-08 season when the Wildcats posted a 17-game winning streak.

THE NEXT STEP

Daemen made its third straight appearance in the ECC Championship in 2020, but did not have a win in the tournament until posting victories over New York Tech (76-56) and Molloy (68-56) to claim its first-ever ECC Tournament title.

20/20

Last year, Daemen reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since the 2012-13 season—and the 16th time in program history.

PICKING UP WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

Daemen got the long-awaited 2020-21 season underway Jan. 16 with an impressive 82-64 win over regionally ranked Mercyhurst, ending a 314-day gap between contests due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and have won seven of their first eight contests to start their new campaign. The Wildcats have won 26 of their last 29 games and are 48-8 since Jan. 11, 2019.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Daemen has held 34 of its last 40 opponents to 65 points or less, posting a 30-2 record in those games. In 2019-20, Daemen collected 256 steals – the team's most since 355 in 2012-13 – and finished the season ranked 13th in the country for scoring defense, allowing just 55.0 points per game.

LONG RANGE THREATS

Last season, Daemen established a new program record for three-pointers made (238) and attempted (752) in a season, besting the previous standards of 236-693 set in 2009-10. Daemen

ranked first among ECC teams in three-pointers made per game (8.5) and three-pointers attempted per game (26.9). The Wildcats also ranked third in three-point field goal percentage (.316). All five of Daemen's starters made at least 29 three-pointers on the year. The Wildcats made a program-record 20 three-pointers in an 89-62 win over Queens on Jan. 10, 2020.

SEASON OPENERS

Daemen's 82-64 win over Mercyhurst snapped a two-game slide in season openers, giving them their first 1-0 start since the 2017-18 season when they defeated American International. Daemen is 24-10 in season openers during the program's modern era (1986-present).

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

With their 65-56 loss hosting Gannon on Jan. 31, Daemen's home-court winning streak was snapped at 20 straight games dating back to the 2018-19 season. This ranked the longest active home winning streak among all East Region teams at the time and was one of the top 10 active streaks among all Division II teams. Daemen went 9-0 at home during the 2019-20 season – the program's first unbeaten home campaign since going 13-0 in 2007-08.

BACK IN THE FOLD

No strangers to consistent play, redshirt senior **Tiara Filbert** and junior **Katie Titus** top the list of returning players after once again earning all-conference honors in 2019-20. As a redshirt junior, Filbert earned first-team All-ECC recognition after averaging team-highs in points (14.4) and assists (3.7). Titus continued to dominate in the ECC in her sophomore campaign. The second-team All-ECC selection averaged 13.1 points and a team-high 8.3 rebounds per game along with a team-high eight double-doubles. Senior **Caroline White** ranked third for Daemen in points (12.9) and second in rebounds (7.0) and served as a two-way player en route to the first All-ECC selection of her career. Fellow senior **Autumn Buchenschutz** also returns as a key player this season. Junior **Mickayla Ivy** and sophomore **Marina Maerkl** also return after being regular

rotation players last season.

FRESH FACES

The 2020-21 roster features several newcomers, including Division I transfer **Mary Foster** (New Hampshire) and freshmen **Natalie Angeletti**, **Alahna Paige** and **Kaytlyn Matz**. Foster spent two seasons at UNH where she appeared in 20 games. As a freshman, the Elmira native averaged 1.4 rebounds in 7.2 minutes. Angeletti won four Section VI Class D championships in five seasons at Panama. In 2020, the Panthers went 20-2 and finished No. 2 in the state poll. Three NYS Class D Final Fours and consecutive state title games (2016-2017) later, the 2020 NYS Class D Player of the Year is their all-time scorer (1,751 points) while also topping 1,000 rebounds. A four-year letter-winner at Irondequoit, Paige scored 28.6 points per game as a senior, was the All-Greater Rochester Co-Player of the Year and Class A All-State first team after leading the Eagles to a 2020 Section VI Class A championship appearance. She is their all-time scorer at Irondequoit with over 1,000 points. A four-year varsity player at Carmel Catholic, Matz won three regional championships and made Sweet 16 and Elite 8 appearances in the Illinois state playoffs. Team MVP as a senior, Matz was honorable mention all-conference and made the Lake County All-Area team.

HEY ROOKIE

Freshmen **Natalie Angeletti** and **Alahna Paige** have received ECC Rookie of the Week honors this season. Angeletti received the honor after helping Daemen sweep D'Youville in games played Jan. 22 and 24 and narrowly missed her first career double-double, totaling 9 points and 10 rebounds in the second matchup. Paige received the honor twice after helping Daemen secure wins against Roberts Wesleyan on Feb. 17 and in the first game of a two-game series at Mercy on Feb. 20 and again after scoring a career-high 28 points against St. Thomas Aquinas on Feb. 28. Daemen has now had seven players earn Rookie of the Week honors since the 2013-14 season when the Wildcats began ECC play.

LETHAL LEFTY

A two-time All-ECC selection, redshirt senior guard *Tiara Filbert* returns to lead the team after averaging a team-high 14.4 points and 3.7 assists per game last season – both ranking in the top five among all ECC players. Filbert also became just the sixth player in program history and the first since Chelsea Andorka in 2012-13 to total 400 points and 100 assists in a single season. Filbert enters her senior campaign having played in all 85 games of the past three seasons while making 76 starts.

PRESEASON HONORS

In early January, *Tiara Filbert* was named the ECC Preseason Player of the Year following a vote of the league's head coaches. Coming off her the first All-ECC first team selection of her career, Filbert is the first women's basketball player from Daemen to earn ECC Preseason Player of the Year honors.

MILESTONE MOMENT

With a free throw at the 5:26 mark of the second quarter during Daemen's season-opening win over Mercyhurst, *Tiara Filbert* reached the 1,000-point plateau for her career, becoming the 25th player in program history to do so. The milestone came as part of a 20-point outing and led to Filbert's third career selection as the ECC Player of the Week. In 93 career games, Filbert has totaled 1,096 points and ranks 20th on the programs' all-time scoring list.

SELECT COMPANY

With her four rebounds during Daemen's victory at D'Youville on Jan. 22, *Tiara Filbert* now has 401 for her career. She becomes just the 13th player in team history to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds and 200 assists in a career.

Forward *Katie Titus* returns after earning All-ECC second team honors and being named the Most Outstanding Player of the ECC Championship last season. Titus totaled a team-high eight double-doubles, led the team in rebounding (8.3 rpg) and finished second in scoring (13.1 ppg). Titus, who ranked fourth in rebounding and sixth in scoring among the ECC leaders, was one of only four players in the league to average at least 13 points and 8 rebounds per contest. She also ranked second in blocked shots (49), eighth in field goal percentage (.454) and 11th in three-point field goals (40). Titus recorded back-to-back double-doubles and averaged 20.0 points and 13.5 rebounds in Daemen's two ECC tournament victories. Titus burst on the scene as a freshman when she led Daemen in scoring (12.1 ppg) and rebounding (7.2 rpg) en route to earning All-ECC first team and ECC Rookie of the Year honors. She became the first women's basketball player from Daemen to garner a major award from the ECC since the Wildcats joined the conference and also the first freshman to earn All-ECC first team honors since Madison Rowland of Queens College in 2013-14.
