

JUMP BALL

Daemen continues their 2021-22 season this weekend with two games at the Lady Chap Classic hosted by Lubbock Christian. Daemen will face Angelo State Friday night for the first time in program history. Then, Daemen will close the tournament Saturday night by facing host Lubbock Christian - a rematch of Daemen's first Elite Eight appearance in program history. The Lady Chaps are the defending national champions and opened the season ranked No. 1 both Division II national polls.

A MAGICAL RUN

The Wildcats earned their second consecutive NCAA tournament berth and captured their first regional title last March. After entering the tournament as the No. 2 seed in the East Regional, the Wildcats ran to a 73-54 win over third-seeded Georgian Court in the regional semifinals, marking the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. The Wildcats followed up with a 58-40 defeat of fifth-seeded Roberts Wesleyan in the regional final, avenging a loss just nine days prior in the ECC Championship final. Katie Titus was named the Most Outstanding Player of the East Regional after netting 22 points to go with seven rebounds, three blocks and two steals in the regional final. The postseason run came to an end just over a week later in Columbus, Ohio where the Wildcats suffered a 66-49 loss in the Elite Eight to top-seeded and eventual national champion Lubbock Christian.

RELOADED

Daemen is set to return 13 players, including four starters, from their regional championship team players responsible for 78% of scoring, 81% of rebounds and 85% of their assists from a season ago. Among the returners is senior forward Katie Titus who was recently named the ECC Preseason Player of the Year. A 6-foot forward, Titus produced a career-high 14.8 points per game last season. She led the ECC in three-point field goals (48) and blocks (40) while also ranking second in rebounding (8.1 rpg) and third in scoring en route to earning honorable mention All-American honors. Redshirt senior quard Tiara Filbert - the 2020-21 ECC Preseason Player of the Year - is also set to return after being limited to just eight games by an injury last season. A three-time All-ECC selection, Filbert enters her final collegiate season with 1,096 points in 93 games played. Senior forward Mickayla Ivy (9.4 ppg, 6.5 rpg) and sophomore guard Alahna Paige (2020-21 ECC Rookie of the Year) also return.

BANK ON IT

Jenepher Banker returns for her sixth season on the Daemen bench and her 11th overall as a collegiate head coach. The veteran mentor has led Daemen to a 79-51 record since taking the reins in 2016, with 56 of her victories coming over the past four seasons. The Wildcats' success under Banker includes a 23-win season in 2019-20 (a benchmark for wins during the program's NCAA Division II era), back-to-back regular season conference titles, the program's first ECC tournament championship, a pair of NCAA tournament berths and the 2021 regional title. She was named the ECC Coach of the Year after leading the Wildcats to an unbeaten run through conference play. Including her five seasons as the head coach at Penn State Behrend, Banker enters the season just four wins shy of 150 for her career.

IN THE POLLS

For the first time in the program's NCAA Division II era (2015-present), the Wildcats are nationally ranked to start the season. Daemen was ranked 20th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Preseason Top 25 Coaches Poll and eighth in the Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA) Preseason Media Poll. The Wildcats ended the 2020-21 season ranked eighth in both polls - the first time they've finished a season in the national rankings.

MILESTONE CHASE

Senior forward Katie Titus opened the season needing just 42 points to become the 27th member of Daemen's 1,000-point club. As of November 18, in 75 career games, Titus has made 67 starts and totaled 998 points, 595 rebounds and 129 blocked shots. A three-time All-ECC selection, Titus is also bidding to become just the fourth player in program history to have 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks in a career.

HIGH ECC-XPECTATIONS

For the second straight season, Daemen has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the ECC. The Wildcats were the near unanimous choice atop the ECC Preseason Coaches' Poll, garnering nine of the 10 first-place votes and 97 points. The Wildcats posted a 9-0 ECC record last season - the program's first unbeaten conference season since 2003-04 - and hold a 37-6 conference mark over the past three seasons.

ANGELO STATE SCOUTING REPORT

The Angelo State Belles are members of the Lone Star Conference and are led by first-year head coach Alesha Ellis. Ellis was hired as the new coach on June 4th following an eight-year stint with NAIA institution Wayland Baptist, where she led the Flying Queens to the NAIA Tournament all eight seasons, compiling a winning percentage of .784 and 189 career wins. Ellis led the Flying Queens to a program-best 31 wins in the 2019-20 season and was Sooner Athletic Conference (SAC) Coach of the Year four times. Only two players (Sawyer Lloyd, Samantha Rocha) return from the Belles' 2019-20 team that finished 18-10 overall and qualified for an NCAA Tournament berth before the postseason was cancelled due to the early stages of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. Angelo State did complete an abbreviated season this past winter, finishing 1-13 overall.

Angelo State returns five players from last season's team, including their two top scorers in sophomore guard Sawyer Lloyd and freshman guard Madeline Stephens. Named to the Lone Star All-Conference second team, Lloyd averaged a team-high 14.6 points per game and led the team in assists (45) and steals (38). Stephens was second in points per game (12.8) and led in rebounds per game (8.9) and total blocks (19.)

Seven true freshmen and five transfers, including former Wayland Baptist players Blakely Gerber, Payton Brown and Tayjanna McGhee-Pleasant, round out the roster.

The Rambelles were picked fourth in the Lone Star Conference preseason poll, behind only Lubbock Christian, West Texas A&M and Texas A&M-Commerce.

LUBBOCK CHRISTIAN SCOUTING REPORT

The Lubbock Christian Lady Chapparals are members of the Lone Star Conference and are led by veteran coach Steve Gomez. Now in his 18th season with the program, Gomez has led the Lady Chaps to 436 wins and, most recently, won the NCAA Division II National Championship this past spring in Columbus, Ohio. Gomez and LCU have won three national championships (2016, 2019, 2021), four South Central Region titles, and is the first Division II program to post multiple undefeated seasons. LCU returns 11 players, including three starters (Ashton Duncan, Juliana Robertson, Allie Schulte) from the Lady Chaps' 2020-21 team that finished 23-0 overall.

Named the Elite Eight Most Outstanding Player, graduate student and guard Allie Schulte was also a member of the LSC's All-Conference (First Team) and All-Defensive Team, averaging team-highs in points per game (15.1), assists per game (3.6), steals per game (2.9) and shot nearly 58% from the field.

Graduate student and guard Ashton Duncan was a Second Team All-LSC selection last season and averaged 11.7 points per game. Her 202 career-three pointers moves her into the top five in program history in career three-pointers. Graduate student forward Juliana Robertson has appeared in 110 games in her career thus far and is averaging a team-high 6.2 rebounds per game in 2021-22.

The Lady Chaps were picked first overall in both the NABC and Lone Star Conference preseason polls.

JENEPHER BANKER HEAD COACH • SIXTH SEASON • SPRINGFIELD, '85

Jenepher Banker will embark on her sixth season as the head women's basketball coach at Daemen College in 2021-22 as she continues to build Western New York's premier NCAA Division II program. Banker was <u>introduced in 2016 as the fourth head coach</u> in the modern era of the program and has since led the Wildcats to a 79-51 overall record and a 54-25 mark in East Coast Conference play.

The veteran mentor has presided over the program's resurgence in recent years, leading the Wildcats to back-to-back ECC regular season championships, an ECC tournament title and two NCAA tournament berths. From early January of 2019 through the start of the 2021-22 season, Banker's Wildcats are 52-11.

The 2020-21 season was a historic one as Banker guided the Wildcats to the NCAA Division II East Region championship, advancing to the Elite Eight for the first time in the program's NCAA era. It was a remarkable run, especially considering the circumstances. The start of the season was delayed until mid-January due to the COVID-19 pandemic, but once it got underway, the Wildcats were off and running. They rattled off 12 wins in their first 13 contests with the only setback coming against nationally ranked Gannon. The success included a 9-0 run through ECC play as the Wildcats completed an unbeaten conference slate for just the third time in program history.

After stumbling in the final round of the ECC Championship, Banker refocused the group heading into NCAA tournament play. With the East Regional held on their home floor at Lumsden Gymnasium, the second-seeded Wildcats ousted third-seeded Georgian Court 73-54 to secure the program's first-ever NCAA tournament victory. Banker and the squad would go on to cut down the nets following a 58-40 win over fifth-seeded and long-time rival Roberts Wesleyan in the regional final, avenging their conference tournament loss to the Redhawks and snapping their region-best nine-game winning streak in the process.

Daemen's historic run came to an end at the Greater Columbus (Ohio) Convention Center where, as the No. 8 seed, they fell 66-49 to top-seeded and eventual national champion Lubbock Christian. The Wildcats ended the year ranked eighth in national polls conducted by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and Division II Sports Information Directors of America (D2SIDA). They were driven all season by their defense, finishing third in the country in both scoring defense (51.6 ppg) and field goal percentage defense (.325).

Banker guided the squad to a 23-5 overall record - the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13 - as well as a share of the ECC regular season championship and the ECC tournament title during the 2019-20 campaign. They did so by combining stingy defense with solid offensive production, especially from behind the three-point arc. The Wildcats allowed just 55.0 points per game, ranking 13th in the country, and went 9-1 when holding opponents to less than 50 points. On the offensive end, Daemen set program records for three-pointers made in a game (20 vs. Queens on January 10) and season (238) and ranked first in the ECC for three-pointers made per game (8.5). Daemen's +14.1 scoring margin also topped the ECC and ranked 30th nationally.

The team's success in 2019-20 included a 13-game winning streak spanning some 69 days - the longest winning streak of the program's NCAA Division II era. The Wildcats also posted a 9-0 record at home, going undefeated for the third time in program history and for the first time since 2007-08.

After going 13-3 during the conference regular season, the Wildcats experienced postseason success with two wins at the ECC tournament which was played at the UDC Sports Complex in Washington, D.C. Second-seeded Daemen knocked off third-seeded New York Tech in the semifinals, 76-56, on March 7. A day later, Banker led the Wildcats

to a 68-56 win over fourth-seeded Molloy in the finals, riding the double-double performance (24 points, 13 rebounds) of sophomore forward Katie Titus who was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

The conference tournament title came with an automatic bid to the 2020 NCAA tournament. Daemen was awarded the No. 7 seed in the East Region, and was set to make its NCAA tournament debut against second-seeded Stonehill. However, the tournament was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The groundwork for championship seasons was laid in the years prior. Inheriting a team that won nine games in the season before her arrival, Banker led the team to 11 wins in her debut season and 12 more during the 2017-18 campaign which included the program's first ECC tournament berth.

In 2018-19, Banker led the Wildcats to an 18-10 overall record and a 15-3 mark in conference games. The 15 conference wins established a new benchmark for Daemen's ECC era as the Wildcats placed second in the ECC standings. The Wildcats also achieved their first-ever regional ranking at the Division II level that season, debuting in the D2SIDA East Region media poll in a tie for No. 10 on February 4. They later debuted at No. 10 in the official NCAA regional poll released on February 20. Daemen's ascent into the regional conversation came in the midst of winning 14 of their final 15 regular season contests, including a streak of 11 in a row. Banker picked up her 100th win as a collegiate head coach along the way, a 79-47 defeat of conference foe District of Columbia on

on January 27.

Over her first five seasons at the helm, Banker has played an integral role in the development of eight all-conference players. Those players account for 14 total all-conference selections, including firstteam picks Sarah Saba (2017, 2018), Katie Titus (2019, 2021), Tiara Filbert (2020, 2021) and Caroline White (2020, 2021). Additionally, Titus (2019 ECC Rookie of the Year), White (2021 ECC Player of the Year) and Alahna Paige (2021 ECC Rookie of the Year) have garnered major ECC awards during Banker's tenure. Also in 2021, Banker was named the ECC Coach of the Year while White and Titus picked up honorable mention All-American honors from he WBCA.

Banker holds more than 30 years of coaching experience at various levels, ranging from Division I to high school. Her first collegiate experience came as an assistant coach at Iowa State University, then of the Big Eight Conference, from 1986-88, and later as an assistant at Canisius College from 1993-95.

Between assistant coaching stops, Banker served as the head coach at Penn State-Behrend in Erie, Pa. While there, she led the Lions' NCAA Division III program to a 67-61 overall record, including a 41-12 mark in her final two seasons. Her 1991-92 team went 23-4, winning the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) South Region championship. That season, her team garnered Penn State-Behrend's first-ever national ranking in any sport. She still ranks second all-time in coaching victories, and was inducted into Penn State-Behrend's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1994.

Later, Banker settled at the high school level, coaching the varsity team at Grand Island High School from 1998-2013, building the Lady Vikings into a regional contender with seven Section VI championships, four appearances in the Far West Regional, and one appearance at the New York State final four. During her tenure, Banker's teams were recognized with the New York State Scholar-Athlete Team Award for 15 straight seasons, and she developed 10 players that went on to play college basketball, as well as four of the five 1,000-point scorers in school history.

In addition, Banker has also coached twice in the Empire State Games, formerly a set of annual Olympic-style competitions for amateur athletes from the state of New York.

Banker, who played collegiately and was an Academic All-American and 1,000-point scorer at Springfield College (Mass.), graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1985 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Physical Education. She would later add a Master of Science Degree in Athletic Administration from Iowa State in 1988. After serving as a physical education instructor at Iowa State, Penn State-Behrend and Canisius, she had, since 1998, been a physical education teacher in the Grand Island School District where she has also served as the Director of Community Education.

She resides in Grand Island with her husband, Brett. Together, the couple has raised two children. Their son, Kolby, is the head women's soccer coach at Erie Community College. Their daughter, Kallie, is a former Division I basketball player at both the University of Rhode Island and the University of Vermont, who now serves as Daemen's top assistant.

SWEET CAROLINE

The biggest missing piece from last season is forward Caroline White who was lost to graduation last spring. White earned ECC Player of the Year honors last season after averaging 15.2 points (second in ECC) and 8.5 rebounds (first in ECC) per game.

T IT UP

Daemen will regain the services of redshirt senior guard Tiara Filbert to start the 2021-22 season. A three-time All-ECC selection, Filbert missed the final nine games last season with an injury. Entering the season, she has appeared in 93 games in her career, averaging 11.8 points, 4.6 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game. In Daemen's 2020-21 season opener, she became the 25th member of the program's 1,000 Point Club. Filbert currently ranks 18th in program history with 1,114 career points.

BREAKOUT SEASON

Senior forward Mickayla Ivy will look to take her game to another level after experiencing a breakout campaign in 2020-21. After averaging 2.8 points and 2.6 rebounds per game in her first two seasons, Ivy emerged as a consistent performer at both ends of the floor last season. She started all 17 contests and averaged 9.4 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 50% from the field. Her contributions were recognized by the ECC coaches who voted her onto the All-ECC Second Team.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

Daemen has held 39 of its last 47 opponents to 65 points or less, posting a 36-3 record in those games. The Wildcats were among the best defensive teams in the country in 2020-21, ranking third nationally in both field goal percentage defense (.325) and scoring defense (51.6).

SUSTAINED SUCCESS

Daemen has posted a 52-11 record in their last 63 games, a span that dates back to mid-January of 2019. The Wildcats have won 11 of their 14 regular season, non-conference games in that time.

FRESH FACES

Daemen welcomes just two newcomers to the roster this season. Junior guard Sarah Cloutier is a transfer from NAIA affiliate Southeastern where she appeared in 38 games over two seasons while helping the Fire post a 53-6 record. Guard Sydney Hvizdzak is the lone freshmen on Daemen's roster. She comes to the Wildcats after earning All-Western New York honors last winter when she averaged 26.9 points and 9.6 rebounds per game while leading Randolph to the Section VI Class C title game. Hvizdzak is one of only 15 women in Section VI history to surpass 2,000 career points.

TUNING UP

Daemen got a dress rehearsal opportunity last week as they met Division I Buffalo in an exhibition contest at Alumni Arena. The highly touted Bulls, who are picked to win the MAC tournament this season, scored a 98-43 win in the teams' third exhibition matchup since 2010. Kaytlyn Matz (11 points) and Mickayla Ivy (10 points, five rebounds) led the Wildcats.

SEASON OPENING SPLIT

Daemen opened the season by splitting two games at the Redhawks Classic hosted by Roberts Wesleyan. In a meeting of the last two East Region champions, Daemen held a four-point lead with under five minutes to play before falling 75-70 to Saint Anselm. The Wildcats rebounded with a 72-50 trouncing of Felician the following day. Katie Titus notched doubledoubles in both contests and earned ECC Player of the Week honors. The senior forward netted 24 points in the Wildca's' defeat of Felician, and has scored 10+points in 50 of 75 career games.

TITUS LEADS WILDCATS TO ROMP OVER FELICIAN

ROCHESTER, N.Y. - Senior forward <u>Katie Titus</u> (Penfield, N.Y.) scored 24 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to lead the #20/#8 Daemen to its first win of the 2021-22 season today. The Wildcats dispatched of the Felician Falcons 72-50 in second round action of the Redhawks Classic hosted this weekend by Roberts Wesleyan.

After allowing 75 points in a tight loss to Saint Anselm in their <u>season opener last evening</u>, Daemen got back to its signature stingy defense against the Falcons. Felician was held to just 31% shooting (18-for-59) and committed 22 turnovers which turned into 18 points for the Wildcats. Daemen ranked third in the country last season for both field goal percentage defense (.325) and scoring defense (51.6).

A jumper by newcomer <u>Sarah Cloutier</u> (San Diego, Calif.) sparked a 12-4 Daemen run that spanned the end of the first and start of the second quarters. Titus netted eight points in the spurt, and her layup at the 6:54 mark put Daemen ahead 28-14. The Wildcats outscored Felician 20-9 in the second quarter and took a 38-21 lead into halftime.

An 11-0 third-quarter run for the Wildcats squashed any thoughts of a Felician comeback. The Daemen lead grew to 28 points - its widest margin - when freshman <u>Sydney Hvizdzak</u> (Little Valley, N.Y.) hit a jumper with 2:30 left in the period. The Falcons never got closer than 22 points the rest of the way.

With the win, Daemen evened its record at 1-1. It marked their seventh victory by at least 20 points since the start of last season.

Felician, which dropped a 74-71 decision to Roberts Wesleyan in yesterday's opening round, dropped to 0-2. The Falcons have lost 15 straight games dating back to the 2019-20 season.

IMPACT PLAYERS

- Playing in the 75th game of her career, Titus scored in double figures for the 50th time. She shot 10-for-17 from the field and evenly distributed her points with 12 in each half. Titus now stands just two points shy of 1,000 for her career, and today's effort marked the 19th double-double of her career (second of the season).
- Sophomore guard <u>Kaytlyn Matz</u> (Johnsburg. III.) made a trio of three-pointers and equaled her career-high with 11 points. Matz hit 4-for-10 from the field, including 3-for-7 from downtown.
- Guards <u>Tiara Filbert</u> (Batavia, N.Y.) and <u>Alahna Paige</u> (Rochester, N.Y.) chipped in with eight points apiece and combined for 10 assists. Filbert dished a game-high six dimes.
- Senior forward <u>Mickayla Ivy</u> (Grand Rapids, Mich.), who notched a double-double in last night's opener, was limited to just 12 minutes due to foul trouble. Reserve forward <u>Marina Maerk/</u> (Binghamton, N.Y.) and <u>Natalie Angeletti</u> (Randolph, N.Y.) stepped up with Ivy saddled. Maerkl finished with six points, four boards and three assists while Angeletti snagged seven rebounds.
- > Katelyn Andres (11 points) and Mimmi Hahne (10 points) were the lone Felician players to reach double figures. Briana Lee, who averaged a team-high 18.0 points per game last season, was held to eight today on 3-of-12 shooting, but did grab a game-high 12 rebounds.

GAME NOTES

- Daemen is ranked in both Division II national polls for the first time at a season's outset during the program's NCAA era (2015-present). The Wildcats are No. 20 in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association top-25 poll and No. 8 in the Division II Sports Information Directors of America national media poll.
- It marks the sixth time in the last seven seasons that Daemen has opened by participating in a Roberts Wesleyan-hosted tournament. The Wildcats are now 8-4 in those tournament games dating back to the 2015 season.
- > Today's result marked the 39th time in the last 47 games that Daemen has allowed 65 points or less. The Wildcats own a 36-3 record in those contests.
- > Daemen has won eight straight games against affiliates of the Central Atlantic Collegiate Conference. Daemen's last loss to a CACC opponent came on Nov. 14, 2015 against Nyack (64-56).
- Filbert now has 1,114 points in 95 games during her career. In the course of today's game, she passed Allison LaPoint (1,108) and Debbie Braniecki (1,111) to move into 18th place on Daemen's all-time scoring list.
- The Wildcats shot 10-for-11 from the free throw line today. Through two games, the team is shooting 91% from the charity stripe (30-for-33). Daemen is now 62-11 in their last 73 games, a span that dates back to mid January of 2019. The Wildcats are 11-4 in regular season, non-conference games in that span.

NEXT JUMP BALL

The Wildcats are back in action next weekend (Nov. 19-20) when they play two games at the Lady Chap Classic in Lubbock, Texas. Daemen faces Angelo State in their tournament opener before facing defending national champion Lubbock Christian which is ranked first in both Division II national polls to start the season.
